All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " unless otherwise stated.
Press seams open unless otherwise stated.

RST = Right Sides Together
WOF = Width of Fabric (selvage to selvage)

Cutting Instructions

Fabrics A, B, C & D

From each fabric cut 5 strips 2" x WOF

Fabric E

Cut 16 strips 2" x WOF

Fabric F

Cut 8 strips 5" x WOF

- Subcut 60 squares 5" x 5"

Fabric G

Cut 20 strips 2" x WOF

- Subcut 240 squares 2" x 2"

Fabric H

Cut 6 strips 2" x WOF

- Sew strips together end-to-end to create one long strip. Cut two 2" x $54\frac{1}{2}$ " side inner borders and two 2" x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " top and bottom inner borders

Fabric I

Cut 6 strips 5" x WOF

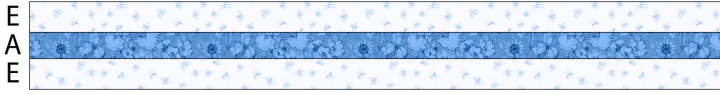
- Sew strips together end-to-end to create one long strip and cut four 5" x $57\frac{1}{2}$ " outer borders

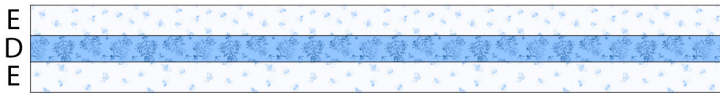
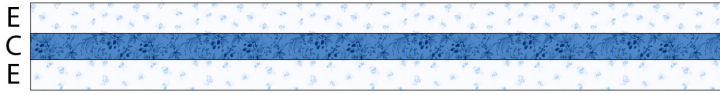
Cut 7 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Piecing Instructions

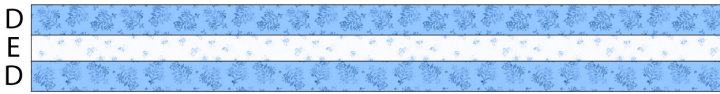
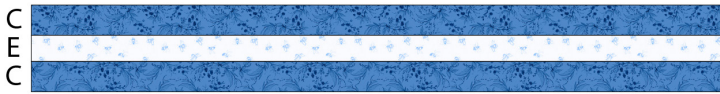
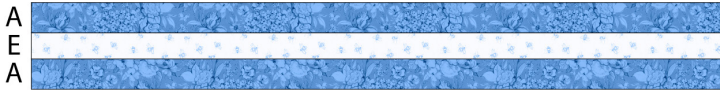
Step 1: Gather two 2" x WOF Fabric E strips and one 2" x WOF Fabric A strip. Sew the strips together along the long edge in the following order: A-E-A. Press.



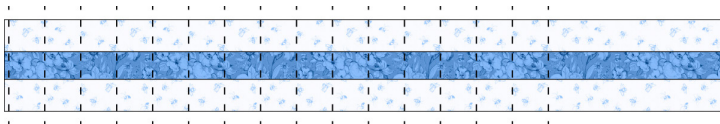
Repeat to make one each of the following strip sets:



Repeat to make two each of the following strip sets:

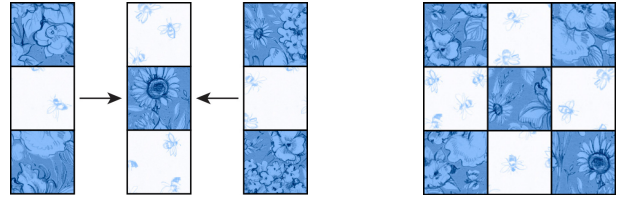


Step 2: Cut each strip set into fifteen 2" x 5" pieces.

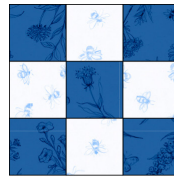


There will be some of each strip set left over, toss or save for another project.

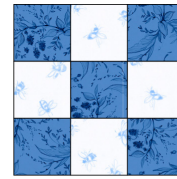
Step 3: Gather 2 A-E-A 2" x 5" pieces and one E-A-E 2" x 5" piece. Sew them together as shown to make a Block A 9-patch. Press. Repeat to make 15 Block A.



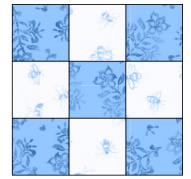
Repeat Step 3 to make 15 each of the following:

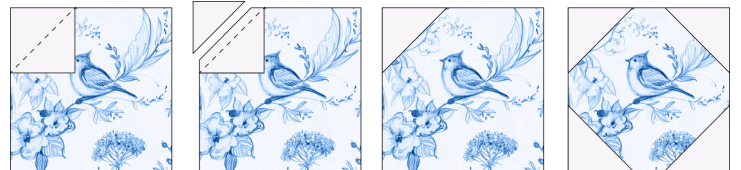

Step 4: Gather 4 Fabric G 2" squares and 1 Fabric F 5" square. Draw a line diagonally across the back of all Fabric F squares. Place a 2" Fabric G square in the corner of the 5" Fabric F square. Sew on the line. Trim 1/4" away from the drawn line and press open. Repeat for remaining 3 corners to make one F block.



Repeat step 4 to make 60 F blocks.

Assembly Instructions

Step 5: To assemble the rows, gather the blocks listed below for each row and sew them together in the order they are listed. Press.

Row 1: C-F-A-F-D-F-B-F-C-F

Row 2: F-D-F-B-F-C-F-A-F-D

Row 3: B-F-C-F-A-F-D-F-B-F

Row 4: F-A-F-D-F-B-F-C-F-A

Row 5: D-F-B-F-C-F-A-F-D-F

Row 6: F-C-F-A-F-D-F-B-F-C

Row 7: A-F-D-F-B-F-C-F-A-F

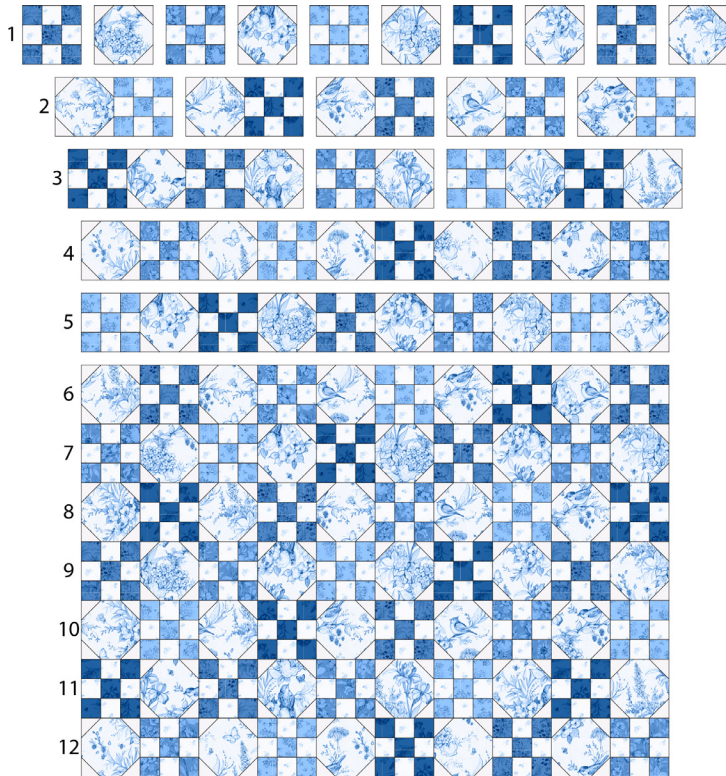
Row 8: F-B-F-C-F-A-F-D-F-B

Row 9: C-F-A-F-D-F-B-F-C-F (same as Row 1)

Row 10: F-D-F-B-F-C-F-A-F-D (same as Row 2)

Row 11: B-F-C-F-A-F-D-F-B-F (same as Row 3)

Row 12: F-A-F-D-F-B-F-C-F-A (same as Row 4)



Step 9: Sew the 2" Fabric H side inner borders to the sides of the quilt top. Press towards border. Sew the 2" Fabric H top and bottom inner borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press towards border

Step 10: Sew the 5" Fabric I side outer borders to the sides of the quilt top. Press towards border. Sew the 5" Fabric I top and bottom outer borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press towards border

Woohoo! Your quilt top is now finished. Now, quilt and bind it using your preferred method. (We love double fold binding!)
