Star At Sea Quilt

Approximate size: 51" x 51" square

Skill Level: Intermediate (knowledge of template piecing required)


IB94-K1

Binding: 1/2 yard IB17-E1, strips cut at 2 1/4" wide and pieced using diagonal seams to make a continuous binding strip.

Backing: 55" x 55" piece of fabric (3 1/8 yards of fabric)

Cutting Directions

Note: When cutting triangular pieces, alternate the orientations of the template as shown in the following to cut more pieces from 1 fabric strip. 1 strip should be able to accommodate 18 pieces, if cut closely.



- 1. From IB28-E1, cut for
- a. pieced blocks

widthwise, 3 (3 1/2" x 42") strips. Subcut 16 "D" and 16 "G" pieces using provided templates.

- 2. From IB107-E1, cut for
- a. pieced blocks

widthwise, 2 (3 1/2" x 42") strips. Subcut 16 "F" pieces using provided templates.

widthwise, 1 (4" xx 4") strip. Subcut 16 "A" pieces using provided templates.

- 3. From NC28-02, cut for
- a. pieced blocks, using provided templates

widthwise, 13 (3 1/4" x 42") strips. Subcut 128 "B", 64 "C" and 32 "E" pieces using provided templates.

Note: When cutting the pieces, alternate the orientations of the template as shown in the

- 4. From IB94-K1, cut for
- a. pieced blocks

widthwise, 6 (3 1/4" x 42") strips. Subcut 64 "C" and 32 "D" pieces using provided templates.

b. inner border #1

widthwise, 5 (3" x 42") strips. Piece strips using straight seams, and subcut 2 (3" x 40 1/2") and 2 (3" x 45 1/2") strips.

c. outer border

widthwise, 5 (3" x 42") strips. Piece strips using straight seams, and subcut 2 (3" x 46 1/2") and 2 (3" x 51 1/2") strips.

- 5. From IB105-G2, cut for
- a. pieced blocks

widthwise, 3 (3 1/4" x 42") strips. Subcut 16 "D", "F" and "G" pieces using provided templates. widthwise, 1 (4" x 42") strip. Subcut 16 "A" pieces using provided templates.

- 6. From NO30-EI, cut for
- a. pieced blocks

widthwise, 2 (3 1/4" x 42") strips. Subcut 16 "D" and 16 "G" pieces using provided templates.

- 7. From IB104-E1, cut for
- a. pieced blocks

widthwise, 1 (3 1/4" x 42") strip. Subcut 16 "F" pieces using provided templates.

widthwise, 1 (4" x 42") strip. Subcut 8 "A" pieces using provided templates.

- 8. From KI04-G1, cut for
- a. pieced blocks

widthwise, 2 (3 1/2" x 42") strips. Subcut 16 "F" pieces using provided templates.

widthwise, 1 (4" xx 4") strip. Subcut 16 "A" pieces using provided templates.


- 9. From IB105-E1, cut for
- a. pieced blocks

widthwise, 3 (3 1/2" x 42") strips. Subcut 16 "D" and 16 "G" pieces using provided templates.

Block Construction (using IB28-E1 and IB107-E1) as example


Description: The block consists of 8 segments - 4 segments A and 4 segments B.

Block assembly diagram:



1. Assembling Segment A.

Sew together 2 IB94-KI "C" and 1 1B28-E1 "G" pieces together as shown in block assembly diagram. Add 1 1B28-E1 "D" and 1 IB107-E1 "A" to the sewn unit to complete 1 segment. Repeat to make a total of 4 segments



2. Assembling Segment B.


Sew together 2 NC28-02 "B" and 1 IB107-E1 "F" pieces together as shown in block assembly diagram. Add 1 NC28-02 "E" piece to the sewn unit to complete 1 segment. Repeat to make a total of 4 segments.

3. Assembling half blocks.

Sew together half block #1 in the following order: Segment A - Segment B - Segment A - Segment B.


Sew together half block #2 in the following border: Segment B - Segment A - Segment B - Segment A.

4. Sew the half blocks together to complete 1 block.



5. Use the same procedure to make a total of the following blocks, noting the appropriate fabrics used:


4 IB28-E1/IB107-E1 blocks




4 IB105-E1/KI04-G1 blocks



2 IB105-G2 blocks with IB105-G2 center




2 IB105-G2 blocks with NC28-02 center



2 NO30-E1/IB104-E1 blocks with IB105-G2 center




2 NO30-E1/IB104-E1 blocks with NC28-02 center




Quilt Center Assembly

1. Arrange and sew together the blocks to complete quilt center, as shown.



Quilt Top Assembly

1. Inner border #1. Sew 2 (3" x 40 1/2") IB94-K1 strips to the opposite sides of quilt center. Sew 2 (3" x 45 1/2") IB94-K1 strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.



2. Inner border #2. Sew 2 (1" x 45 1/2") IB104-E1 strips to the opposite sides of quilt center. Sew 2 (1" x 46 1/2") IB104-E1 strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.




3. Outer border. Sew 2 (3" x 46 1/2") IB94-K1 strips to the opposite sides of quilt center. Sew 2 (3" x 51 1/2") IB94-K1 strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.




Quilting Instructions


- 1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste quilt sandwich.
- 2. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Square up quilt before attaching binding strip, hanging sleeve and label.



Cut at 2 1/4" wide and pieced using diagonal seams to make a continuous bias strip.

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
