## Cutting Instructions

Fabrics A-F, H, I, K & L	Cut one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip for strip piecing for
Fabric G	Cut one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip for strip piecing Cut three $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for strip piecing
Fabric J	Cut one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip for strip piecing Cut six $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for outer border


## Cutting Instructions

Fabric M	Cut four 2½" x WOF strips for strip piecing
Fabric N	Cut nine 2½" x WOF strips for strip piecing
Fabric O	Cut two strips 6½" x WOF for strip piecing Cut ten 2½" x WOF strips for strip piecing Cut six 1½" x WOF strips for inner border
Binding	Cut seven 2½" x WOF strips


## Piecing Instructions

### Block A

**Step 1:** Sew the following 2½" x WOF strips together along the long edge to make a Column 1 strip set. Press seams up.



Cut strip set into fifteen 2½" x 10½" pieces.



**Step 2:** Repeat Step 1 to create the following strip sets, pressing seams up on odd numbered columns and down on even numbered columns. Cut fifteen 2½" x 10½" pieces from each strip set.



**Step 3:** Gather one of each columns 1-5. Sew them together in order from 1 to 5 noting orientation of the columns. Press.



Repeat to make a total of 15 Block A.

### Block B

**Step 4:** In the same manner as Block A, sew the following strips together to make a Column 1 strip set. Press seams up.


2½" Fabric M  
6½" Fabric O  
2½" Fabric M



Repeat to make 2 Column 1 strip sets. Cut strip sets into thirty 2½" x 10½" strips.

## Piecing Instructions Cont.


**Step 5:** Repeat step 4 with the following fabrics to make a column 2, press seams down.



Repeat to make 3 Column 2 strip sets. Cut strip sets into fifteen 6 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.

**Step 6:** Gather 2 Column 1 and one column two. Sew them together in the following order making sure the seams are going alternate directions.


Column 1 - Column 2 - Column 1



Repeat to make a total of 15 Block B.

### Quilt Assembly

**Step 7:** Gather 3 Block A and 2 Block B. Sew them together alternating Block A and Block B, noting orientation of Block A. Press. Repeat to make 3 Row A.




**Step 8:** Gather 3 Block B and 2 Block A. Sew them together alternating Block B and Block A, noting orientation of Block A. Press. Repeat to make 3 Row B.



**Step 9:** Sew rows together starting with a Row A, and alternating Rows A & B. Make sure to note orientation of rows. Press.

**Step 10:** Sew the 1 1/2" x WOF Fabric O strips together end to end to create one long strip. From resulting strip cut two 1 1/2" x 60 1/2" side inner borders and two 1 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips for the top and bottom inner borders.

**Step 11:** Sew the 4 1/2" x WOF Fabric J strips together end to end to create one long strip. From resulting strip cut two 4 1/2" x 62 1/2" side outer borders and two 4 1/2" x 60 1/2" strips for the top and bottom outer borders.



*Woohoo!* Your quilt top is finished. Now, quilt and bind using your preferred method.


