### Cutting Instructions

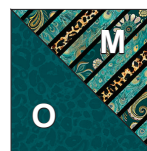
B	Fussy cut a $8\frac{1}{2}$ " square with a left facing Peacock in the center
K	2 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
M	1 - $4\frac{7}{8}$ " strip cut into 4 - $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares
O	1 - $4\frac{7}{8}$ " strip cut into 4 - $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares
Q	2 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips

### Piecing Instructions

**Step 1:** Cut the Fabric O and Fabric M  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares in half on the diagonal. *Make sure to cut in the opposite direction of the stripes on the M squares as shown.*

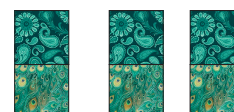


**Step 2:** Sew a Fabric O and a Fabric M triangle together along the long edge. Press. Make (8)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Units 1.

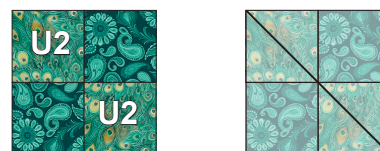
**Step 3:** Sew 1 Fabric K strip to 1 Fabric Q strip. Press. Repeat to make a second strip set. From each strip set, cut (8)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Units (2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished size). Cut a total of 16 Units 2.



Unit 2

**Step 4:** Sew 2 of the Unit 2 together alternating colors (4½" unfinished size). Press. Make 8 Units 3.

On 4 of the Unit 3 draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the units as shown. Make sure to draw the diagonal through the Fabric Q squares.



Unit 3

**Step 5:** Arrange 1 marked Unit 3 right sides together with the 8½" Fabric B square, lining up a corner as shown. Sew along the diagonal line. Trim seam allowance to ¼" and press. Repeat for each corner using the remaining marked Unit 3. Make 1 Unit 4.



Unit 4

**Step 6:** Sew 2 Unit 1 together as shown. Press. Make 4 Units 5.



Unit 5

**Step 7:** Arrange Units 3, 4 and 5 in rows as shown. Sew blocks into rows. Press. Sew rows together. Press.

Make a total of 1 Block 1. (16½" unfinished size)

E	2 - $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF strips cut into 8 - $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $8\frac{7}{8}$ " rectangles
K	1 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 21" strips cut into 8 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
M	First Cut: 2 - $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x 18" strips off the SHORT end of your Half Yard, cut into 4 - $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $8\frac{7}{8}$ " rectangles Then Cut: 2 - $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $32\frac{1}{2}$ " strips cut into 4 - $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $8\frac{7}{8}$ " rectangles and 1 - $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square 1 - $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $32\frac{1}{2}$ " strips cut into 7 - $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

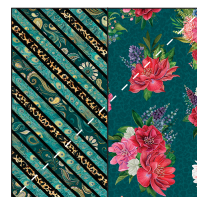
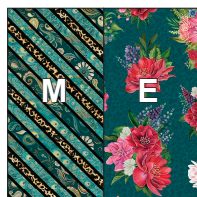
**Step 1:** Sew  $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $8\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric M and Fabric E rectangles right sides together, as shown, paying close attention to the direction of Fabric M stripes. Trim to  $8\frac{7}{8}$ " square, making sure to keep the seam centered. Press. Make 4.

Cut the trimmed squares in half diagonally as shown. Keep only the half shown. Make 4 Units 1.

**Step 2:** Sew  $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $8\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric M and Fabric E rectangles together as shown, paying close attention to the direction of Fabric M stripes. Trim to  $8\frac{7}{8}$ " square, making sure to keep the seam centered. Press. Make 4.



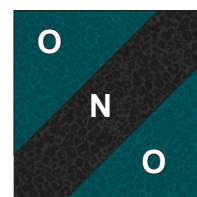
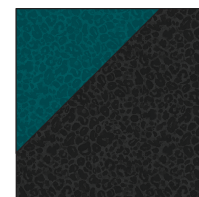
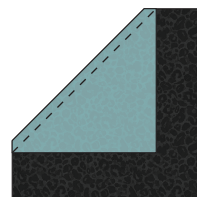
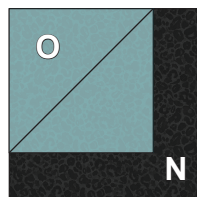

Cut the trimmed squares in half diagonally as shown. Keep only the half shown. Make 4 Units 2.

**Step 3:** Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K squares,  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric M squares, and  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric O squares. For the Fabric M squares, draw the diagonal the opposite direction from the stripes as shown.

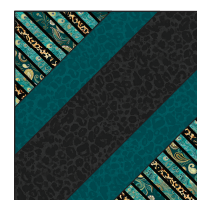
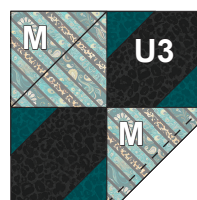


**Step 4:** Arrange a marked  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric O square on the corner of a  $8\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric N square, right sides together. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to  $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press. Repeat on the opposite corner. Make 4 Units 3.



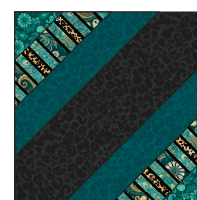
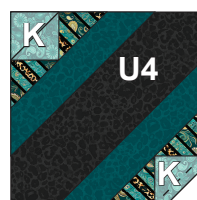

**Step 5:** Arrange a marked  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric M square right sides together on Fabric O corners of a Unit 3 as shown. Make sure your Fabric M stripes are the correct direction. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to  $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press. Make 4 Units 3.



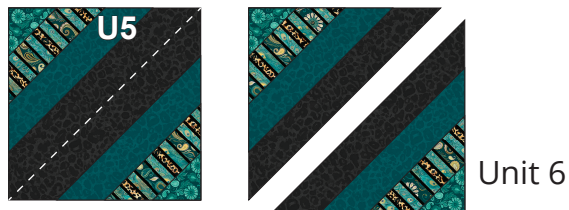

**Step 6:** 4. Arrange a marked  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K square right sides together on M corners of a Unit 4 as shown. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to  $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press. Make 4 Units 5.

**Step 7:** Cut a Unit 5 in half diagonally in the same direction as the strips as shown. Repeat for all Units 5. You will have 8 triangle Units 6.



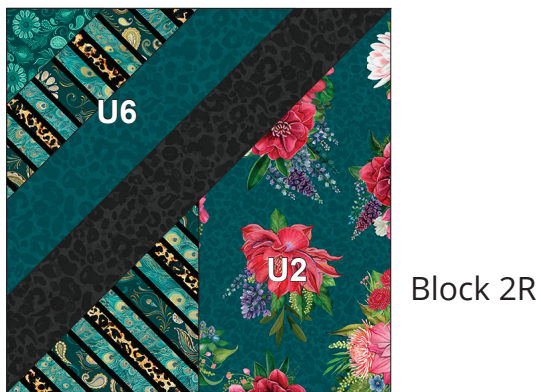
**Step 8:** Sew a Unit 1 triangle with a Unit 6 triangle right sides together. Press.

Make 4 Block 2. (8½" square unfinished)



**Step 9:** Sew a Unit 2 triangle with a Unit 6 triangle right sides together. Press.

Make 4 Block 2R. (8½" square unfinished)

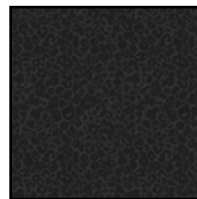

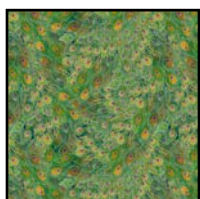

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## Cutting Instructions

H	2 - 2½" x 21" strips cut into 12 - 2½" squares
L	1 - 2⅞" x 21" strip cut into 4 - 2⅞" squares
N	2 - 2⅞" x 21" strips cut into 12 - 2⅞" squares 4 - 2½" x 21" strips cut into 4 - 2½" x 6½" rectangles, and 4 - 2½" x 8½" rectangles
P	2 - 2⅞" x 21" strips cut into 8 - 2⅞" squares

## Piecing Instructions

**Step 1:** Cut the 2⅞" Fabric L, Fabric N, and Fabric P squares in half on the diagonal. *Make sure to cut the opposite direction of the stripes on the L squares as shown.*



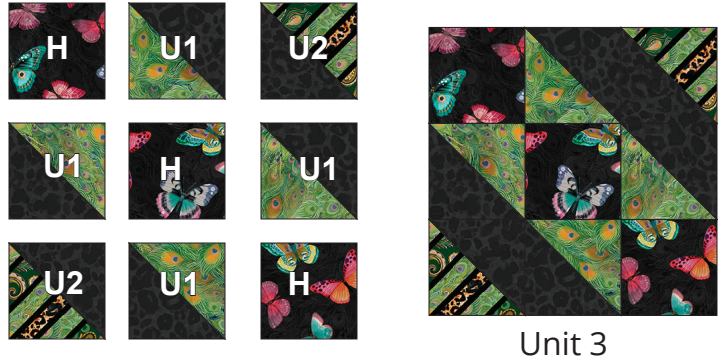
**Step 2:** Sew 2⅞" Fabric N and Fabric P triangles right sides together along the long edge. Press. Make 16 Units 1.



Repeat with 2⅞" Fabric N and Fabric L triangles. Make 8 Units 2.

**Step 3:** Arrange 2½" Fabric H squares with Units 1 and 2 as shown.

Sew together in rows. Press. Then, sew the rows together. Press again. Make 8 Units 3.



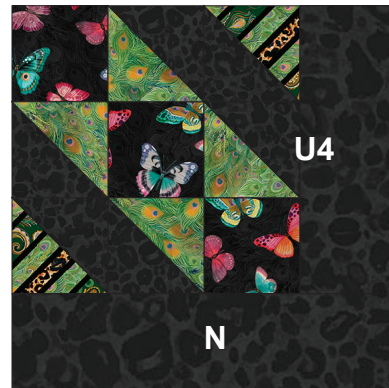
**Step 4:** Sew one 2½" x 6½" Fabric N rectangle to the right side of 1 Unit 3 as shown. Press. Make 4 Units 4.

**Step 5:** Sew one 2½" x 8½" Fabric N rectangle to the bottom of 1 Unit 4 as shown. Press.

Make 4 Blocks 3 (8½" unfinished size).

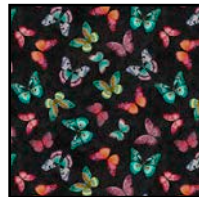

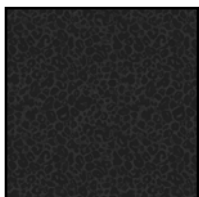

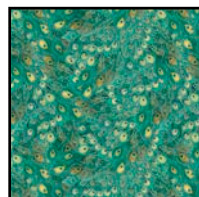

E	2 - 4½" x 21" strip cut into 8 - 4½" squares
H	2 - 2⅝" x 21" strips cut into 16 - 2⅝" squares
N	3 - 3" x 21" strips cut into 16 - 3" inch squares
O	2 - 6⅞" x 42" strips cut into 8 - 6⅞" squares
Q	2 - 4½" x 21" strips cut into 8 - 4½" squares

### Piecing Instructions

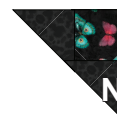
**Step 1:** Cut all the 3" Fabric N squares in half on the diagonal.



**Step 2:** Sew a 3" Fabric N triangle to the left side of a 2⅝" Fabric H square - lining up the top edge of the triangle with the top edge of the square as shown (part of the triangle will extend beyond the square). Press.



Sew a 3" Fabric N triangle to the bottom of the same H square, lining the right edge of the triangle up with the right edge of the square as shown. Press.  
Make 16 Units 1.

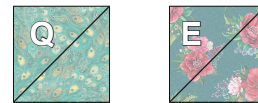

**Step 3:** Sew 1 Unit 1 to each side of a 6½" Fabric C square as shown. Press. Repeat for each of the 6½" Fabric C squares for 4 Peacock Units. Make 2 Peacock Units 1 and 2 Peacock Units 2.



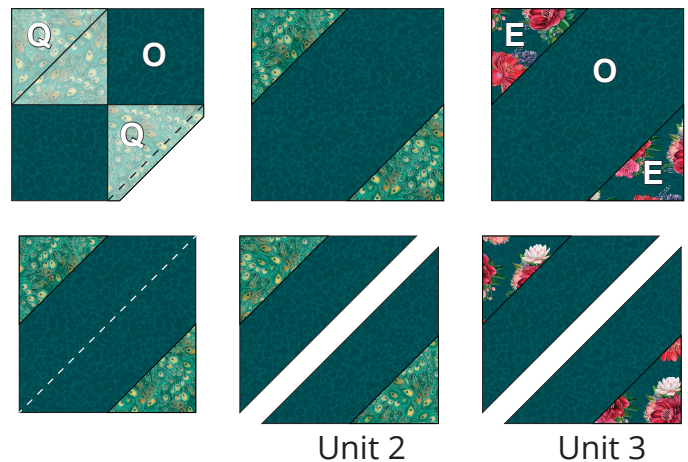
**Step 4:** On the 4½" Fabric E and Fabric Q squares, draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the squares.



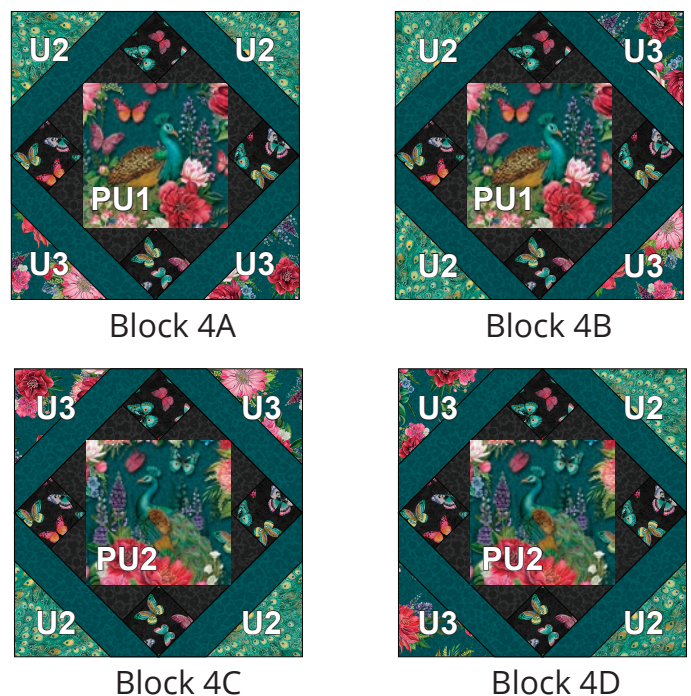
**Step 5:** Arrange a marked 4½" Fabric Q square right sides together on a corner of a 6⅞" Fabric O square as shown. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press. Repeat on the opposite corner. Make 4.

Repeat Step 5 using a marked 4½" Fabric E square on opposite corners of a 6⅞" Fabric O square as shown. Make 4.

Cut in half on the diagonal as shown. Make 8 Unit 2 triangles and 8 Unit 3 triangles.



**Step 6:** Layout the Peacock Units 1 and 2 with the triangle Units 2 and 3 as shown. Pay close attention to the placement of the triangle units. Sew the Units 2 and 3 to the Peacock units, one corner at a time. Press. Make 1 of each Block 4A, 4B, 4C, and 4D (12½" unfinished size).

**Step 2:** On the  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric N and Fabric O squares, draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the squares.



**Step 3:** Arrange a marked  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric O square right sides together on a corner of an  $8\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric E square as shown. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to  $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press. Repeat on the opposite corner. Make 4.



Repeat Step 3 using a marked  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric N square on opposite corners of an  $8\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric D square as shown. Make 4.

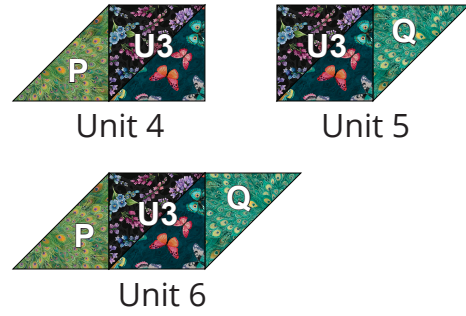
Cut in half on the diagonal as shown, making sure to cut through the Fabric O and Fabric N corners. Make 8 Unit 1 triangles and 8 Unit 2 triangles.

**Step 4:** Sew  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric F and  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric I triangles right sides together. Press. Make 24 Units 3.

**Step 5:** Sew a  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric P triangle to the left side of a Unit 3 as shown. Press. Make 8 Units 4.  
 Sew a  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric Q triangle to the right side of a Unit 3 as shown. Press. Make 8 Units 5.  
 Sew a  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric P triangle to the left side and a  $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric Q triangle to the right side of the same Unit 3 as shown. Press. Make 8 Units 6.



**Step 6:** Sew Units 4, 5, and 6 together as shown. Press. Make 8 Units 7.



**Step 7:** Sew a Unit 2 and a Unit 1 to the sides of a Unit 7 as shown. Press. Make 8 Blocks 5 (12½ unfinished size).

**Step 1:** On the 4½" Fabric P and Fabric D squares, draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the squares.

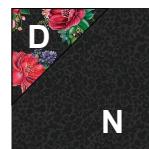


**Step 2:** Arrange a marked 4½" Fabric P square right sides together on a corner of a 6½" Fabric N square as shown. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to  $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press.

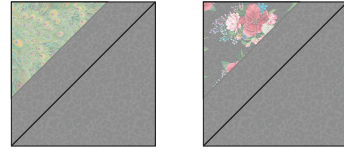

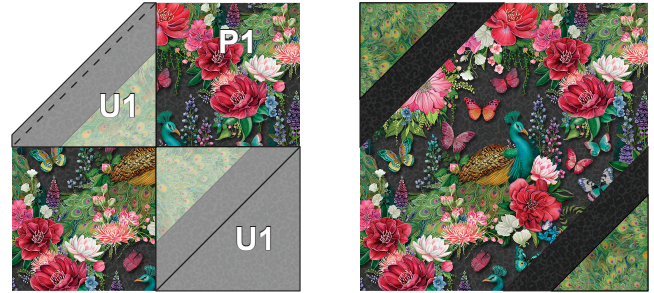

**Step 4:** Arrange a marked Unit 1 right sides together on a corner of a 12½" Fabric B Peacock 1 square as shown. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press. Repeat on the opposite corner. Make 1.



Sew marked Units 2 on the remaining opposite corners as shown. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press. Make 1 Block 6A.

**Step 5:** Layout the remaining Peacock 1 and 2 Units with the remaining Units 1 and 2 as shown. Pay close attention to the placement of the triangle units.

**Step 1:** Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the 3½" Fabric N, Fabric M, and Fabric L squares. Make sure to cut the opposite direction of the stripes on the Fabric L and Fabric M squares as shown.



**Step 2:** Arrange a marked 3½" Fabric N square right sides together on a top corner of a 6½" Fabric E square as shown. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press. Repeat on the remaining top corner.

Sew marked 3½" Fabric L squares on the bottom corners as shown. Press. Make 8 Blocks 7A.

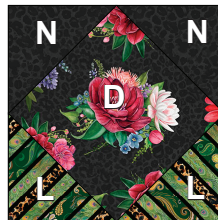

**Step 3:** Layout the remaining 6½" Fabric C, Fabric D, and Fabric E squares with the remaining 3½" Fabric L, Fabric M, and Fabric N squares as shown. Pay close attention to the placement of the corner squares.

In the same way Block 7A was sewn in Step 3, sew the Fabric L, Fabric M, and Fabric N squares to the corners of the Fabric C, Fabric D, and Fabric E squares as shown.

Make 8 Blocks 7A, 8 Blocks 7B, 2 Blocks 7C, and 1 Block of each 7D, 7E, 7F, and 7G (6½" unfinished size).



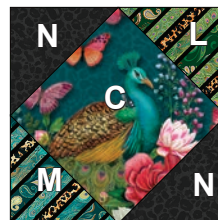

Cut a total of 40 Units 3. Repeat for the 2" Fabric J, Fabric Q, Fabric P and remaining Fabric N strips. Make 40 of each Units 4, 5, and 6.

E	5 - 3½" x WOF strips 5 - 2" x WOF strips
L	8 - 2½" x WOF strips
M	4 - 2½" x WOF strips 4 - 1¾" x WOF strips
O	5 - 2½" x WOF strips 5 - 1¾" x WOF strips
Binding	10 - 2½" x WOF strips

# Assembly Instructions

**Step 1:** Sew a Block 2 to a Block 2R as shown. Press. Make 4 Units 1.



**Step 2:** Arrange Unit 1 with Blocks 6, and B1 as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Blocks and Units. Sew together in rows. Press. Then sew the rows together. Press again. Make 1 Center Unit.



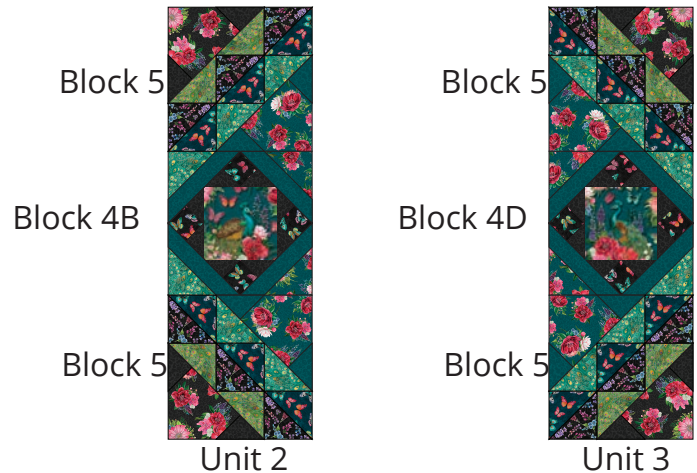
**Step 3:** Sew a 2½" x 32½" Fabric A Butterfly strip to the left side of the Center Unit. Press. Repeat for the right side of the Center Unit. The Butterflies should be facing away from the center.

Sew a 2½" x 36½" Butterfly strip to the top of the Center Unit. Press. Repeat for the bottom of the Center Unit. The Butterflies should be facing away from the center.

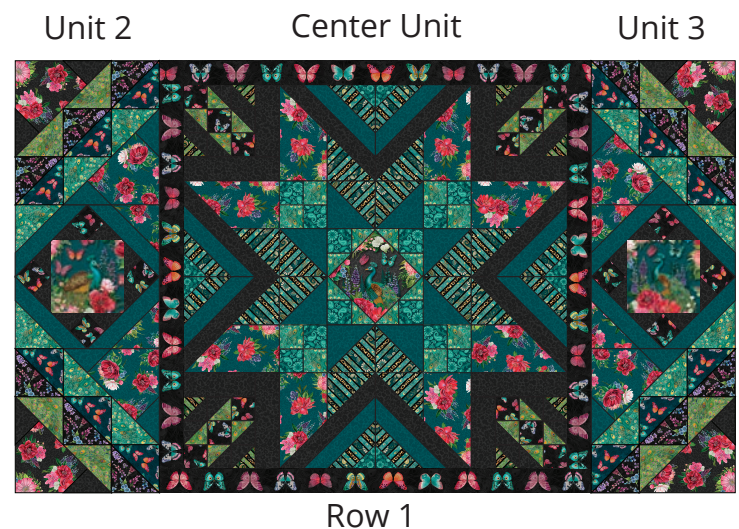


**Step 4:** Sew a Block 5 to the top and bottom of Block 4B as shown. Press. Pay close attention to the direction of the Blocks 5. Make 1 Unit 2.

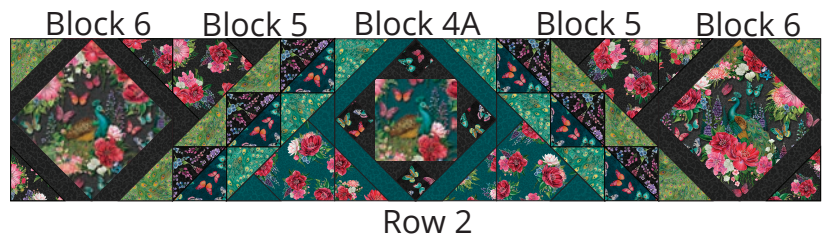
Repeat with Block 4D. Pay close attention to the direction of the Blocks 5. Make 1 Unit 3.



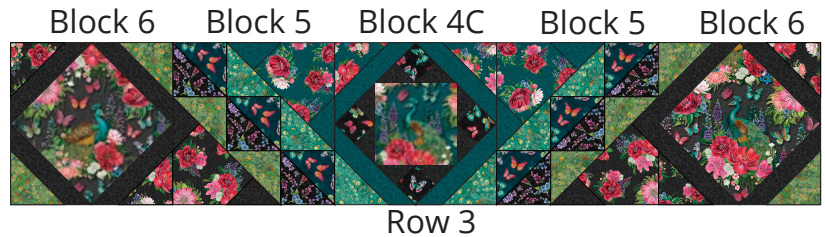
**Step 5:** Arrange Units 2 and 3 on either side of the Center Unit. Sew together. Press. Make one Row 1 Unit.



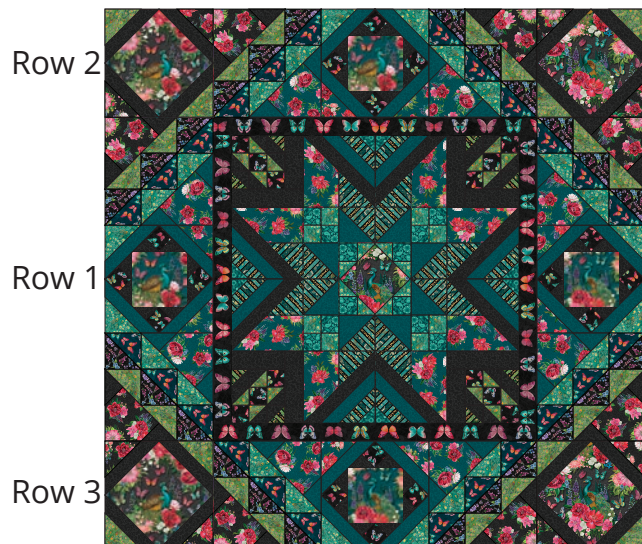
**Step 6:** Arrange 2 of each Blocks 5 and 6 with Block 4A as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Blocks. Sew together. Press. Make one Row 2 Unit.



**Step 7:** Arrange 2 of each Blocks 5 and 6 with Block 4C as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Blocks. Sew together. Press. Make one Row 3 Unit.



**Step 8:** Arrange Rows 1, 2, and 3 together as shown. Sew together. Press.



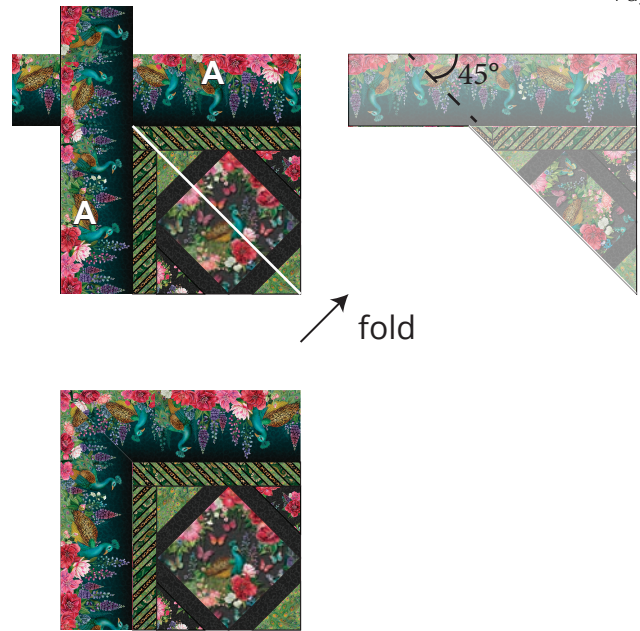
**Step 9:** Sew two 2½" Fabric L strips short ends together. You can measure and cut to 60½" long or use the left side of the quilt to measure and cut your border strips. Sew strip to the left side of the Center Unit. Press. Repeat for the right side of the Center Unit.

Repeat for the top and bottom, either cutting the strips to 64½" long or use the top of the quilt to measure and cut.



**Step 10:** Arrange a Fabric A Peacock border strip centered on a side of the quilt, the Peacocks heads should be pointing toward the center of the quilt. Sew to the quilt, but stop and backstitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each corner, leaving the border ends free. Do not trim yet. Repeat for each side of the quilt.

After the borders are stitched on, fold the quilt on the diagonal, right sides together, aligning the raw edges of two adjacent borders. With a ruler, mark a 45 degree line from the point where the stitching stopped on the border to the raw edge of the border. Sew on the 45 degree line, backstitching at both ends. Before trimming to a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance, check to make sure the corner is sewn correctly. Press. Repeat for each corner.



**Step 11:** Sew two Fabric M  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF strips short ends together. You can measure and cut to  $76\frac{1}{2}$ " long or use the left side of the quilt to measure and cut your border strips. Sew strip to the left side of the quilt. Press. Repeat for the right side of the quilt.

Repeat for the top and bottom, using the Fabric M  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Either cut the strips to 79" long or use the top of the quilt to measure and cut.

**Step 12:** Sew two Fabric E 2" x WOF strips short ends together. You can measure and cut to  $80\frac{1}{2}$ " long or use the left side of the quilt to measure and cut your border strips. Sew strip to the left side of the quilt. Press. Repeat for the right side of the quilt.

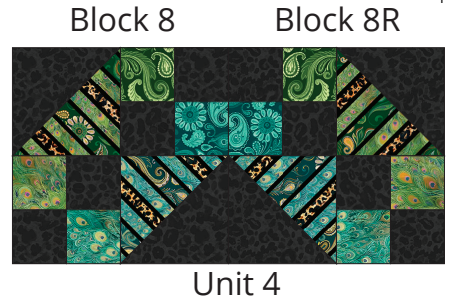
Repeat for the top and bottom, using the Fabric E  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Either cut the strips to 82" long or use the top of the quilt to measure and cut. If you necessary, sew 3 strips together to get the needed length.

**Step 13:** Sew three Fabric O  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF strips short ends together. You can measure and cut to  $86\frac{1}{2}$ " long or use the left side of the quilt to measure and cut your border strips. Sew strip to the left side of the quilt. Press. Repeat for the right side of the quilt, using the excess you cut off from the first strip sewn to two Fabric O  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF strips.

Repeat for the top and bottom, using the Fabric O  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Either cut the strips to  $84\frac{1}{2}$ " long or use the top of the quilt to measure and cut.



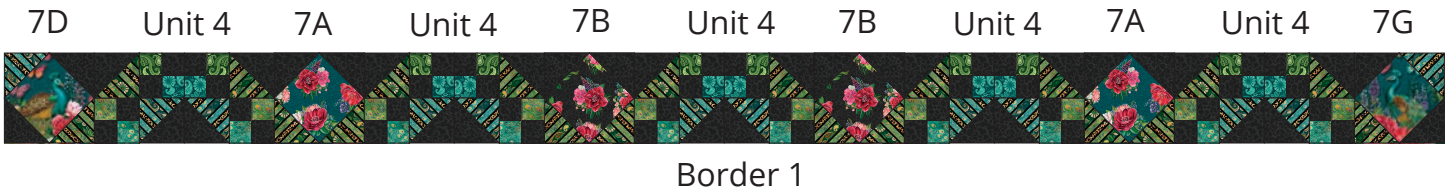
**Step 14:** Sew a Block 8 together with a Block 8R. Pay close attention to the direction of the Blocks. Press. Make 18 Units 4. There will be 2 of each Blocks 8 and 8R remaining.



**Step 15:** Sew a Block 8 and Block 8R on either side of a Block 7C as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Blocks. Press. Make 2 Units 5.



**Step 16:** Arrange 5 Units 4 with two of each of Blocks 7A and 7B and one of each Blocks 7D, and 7G as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Blocks and Units. Sew together. Press. Make 1 Border 1 Unit.



**Step 17:** Arrange 5 Units 4 with two of each of Blocks 7A and 7B and one of each Blocks 7E, and 7F as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Blocks and Units. Sew together. Press. Make 1 Border 2 Unit.



**Step 18:** Arrange 4 Units 4 with two of each of Blocks 7A and 7B and one of each Unit 5 as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Blocks and Units. Sew together. Press. Make 2 Border 3 Units.



**Step 19:** Arrange two Borders 3 on the sides of the Quilt. Pay close attention to the direction of the Borders. Border 3 on the right is flipped. Sew onto the sides of the Quilt. Press.

Sew Border 1 to the top of the Quilt. Press. Sew Border 2 to the bottom of the Quilt. Press. The Peacocks should all be upright.

**Step 20:** Piece the backing at least 6" larger than the quilt top. Layer the backing wrong side up, the batting and the quilt top. Baste together. Quilt. Before binding, hand baste a scant 1/4" around the edge of the quilt to hold the layers together. Piece the binding strips together. Fold the binding in half wrong sides together and press to make a double binding. Sew the binding to the quilt with a 1/4", mitering the corners. Trim excess backing and batting and fold the binding over the back side and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
