N	2 - 2" x WOF strips cut into: 16 - 2" squares 4 - 2" x 3½" rectangles
Q	1 - 3½" x WOF strip cut into 9 - 3½" squares
T	1 - 2" x WOF strip cut into 4 - 2" squares
U	1 - 2" x WOF strip cut into 4 - 2" squares

Piecing Instructions

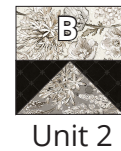
Step 1: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of eight 3½" Q squares.



Step 2: Arrange a marked 3½" Q square RST on the left side of a 3½" x 6½" C rectangle as shown. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press. Repeat on the right side as shown. Make four Units 1.



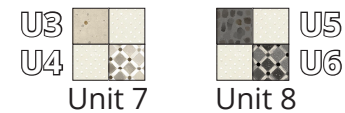
Step 3: Arrange a Unit 1 with a 3½" x 6½" B rectangle as shown. Sew RST together and press. Make four Units 2.



Step 4: Gather all of the 2" squares: I, L, M, N, and T. Sew the squares in pairs as shown, RST. Press. Make four each of Units 3-6.



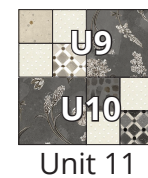
Step 5: Sew a Unit 3 to a Unit 4, RST, as shown. Pay close attention to the position of the Units. Press. Make four Units 7. Repeat with Units 5 and 6. Make four Units 8.



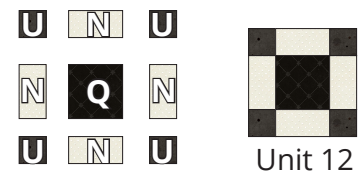
Step 6: Sew a 3½" G square to a Unit 7, RST, as shown. Pay close attention to the position of the Units. Press. Make four Units 9. Repeat with a 3½" G square and a Unit 8. Make four Units 10.



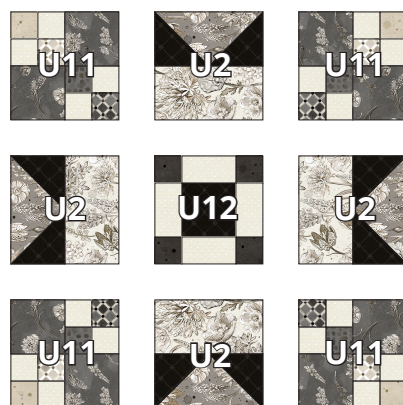
Step 7: Sew a Unit 9 to a Unit 10, RST, as shown. Pay close attention to the position of the Units. Press. Make four Units 11.



Step 8: Arrange four 2" U squares, four 2" x 3½" N rectangles and a 3½" Q square as shown. Sew together in rows, then sew the rows together. Press as you sew. Make one Unit 12.



Step 9: Arrange four each Units 2 and 11 with one Unit 12 as shown, pay close attention to the direction of the Units. Sew together in rows, then sew the rows together. Press as you sew. Make one Block 1.

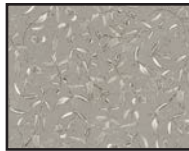

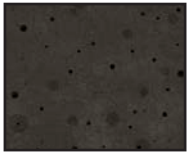

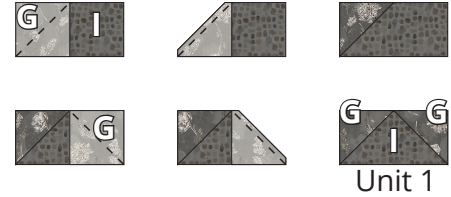

I	3 - 3½" x WOF strip cut into: 8 - 3½" squares 12 - 3½" x 6½" rectangles
J	1 - 3½" x WOF strip cut into 8 - 3½" squares
Q	1 - 3½" x WOF strip cut into 8 - 3½" squares
U	1 - 3½" x WOF strip cut into 4 - 3½" x 6½" rectangles

Piecing Instructions

Step 1: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of eight each 3½" G, I, J, and Q squares.



Step 2: Arrange a marked 3½" G square RST on the left side of a 3½" x 6½" I rectangle as shown. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press. Repeat on the right side as shown. Make four Units 1.



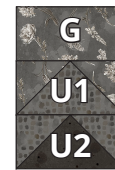
Unit 1

Repeat using marked 3½" I squares with a 3½" x 6½" U rectangle as shown. Make four Units 2.



Unit 2

Step 3: Arrange a 3½" x 6½" G rectangle, a Unit 1, and a Unit 2 together as shown. Sew RST. Press. Make four Units 3.



Unit 3

Step 4: Arrange a marked 3½" J square RST on the left side of a 3½" x 6½" D rectangle and a marked 3½" Q square on the right side, as shown. Sew along the marked lines. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press. Make four Units 4.

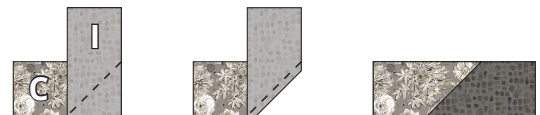
Repeat, this time changing the direction of the marked lines, as shown. Make four Units 5.



Unit 5

Step 5: Arrange a short side of a 3½" x 6½" I rectangle with the bottom right corner of the long side of a 3½" x 6½" C rectangle, RST, as shown.

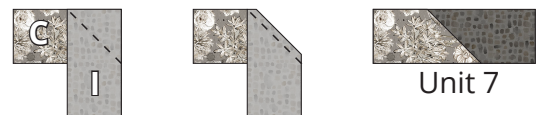
Mark a line from the bottom left corner of the I rectangle to the top right corner of the C rectangle, as shown. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press. Make four Units 6.

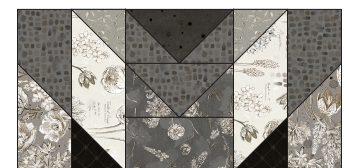
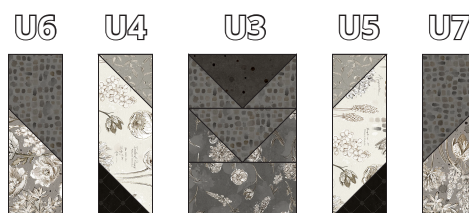
Step 6: Arrange a short side of a 3½" x 6½" I rectangle with the top right corner of the long side of a 3½" x 6½" C rectangle, RST, as shown.

Mark a line from the top left corner of the I rectangle to the bottom right corner of the C rectangle, as shown. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press. Make four Units 7.

Step 7: Arrange Units 3-7 together as shown. Sew, RST. Press as you sew. Make four Blocks 2.

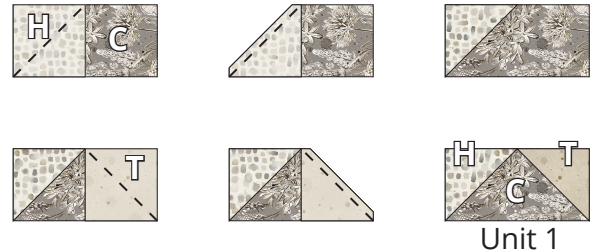

Step 1: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of eight each 3½" H and T squares.



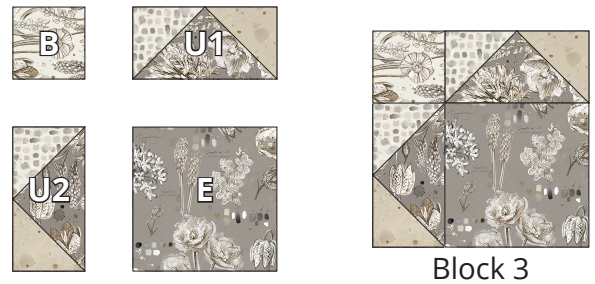
Step 2: Arrange a marked 3½" H square RST on the left side of a 3½" x 6½" C rectangle as shown. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press. Repeat on the right side with a marked 3½" T square as shown. Make four Units 1.



Repeat with a marked 3½" T square on the left side and a marked 3½" H square on the right side, as shown. Make four Units 2.



Step 3: Arrange a Unit 1, a Unit 2, and a 3½" B square with a 6½" E square. Pay close attention to the direction of the Units. Sew together in rows, then sew the rows together. Press as you sew. Make four Blocks 3.

Piecing Instructions

Step 1: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all the 3½" I, N, and Q squares. Also draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 4" N and S squares.



Step 2: Arrange a marked 3½" Q square RST on the left side of a 3½" x 6½" E rectangle as shown. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press. Repeat on the right side as shown. Make eight Units 1.



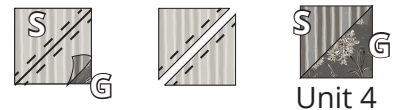
Step 3: Sew a 2" P to a 2" J square, RST. Press. Make 32 Units 2.



Step 4: Sew two Units 2, RST, as shown. Pay close attention to the position of the Units. Press. Make sixteen Units 3.



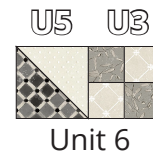
Step 5: Arrange a marked 4" S square with a 4" G square RST. Sew on each side of the diagonal line, ¼" away from the diagonal line as shown. Cut on the center line. Press both. Trim each to a 3½" square, making sure to center the seam. Make eight Units 4.



Repeat with a marked 4" N square and a 4" M square. Make sixteen Units 5.



Step 6: Sew a Unit 3 and a Unit 5, RST, as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Units. Press. Make four Units 6.



Repeat, rearranging the Units 3 and 5 as shown. Make four Units 7.

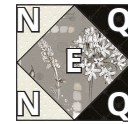


Step 7: Arrange a marked $3\frac{1}{2}$ " I square on a corner of a $6\frac{1}{2}$ " D square as shown, RST. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press. Repeat for all four corners. Make four Units 8.



Unit 8

Repeat, using a $6\frac{1}{2}$ " E square, sewing two marked $3\frac{1}{2}$ " N squares on the left corners and two marked $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Q squares on the right corners, as shown. Make eight Units 9.



Unit 9

Step 8: Lay out two each of Units 3, 4, and $3\frac{1}{2}$ " B squares with one Unit 1 as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Units. Sew, RST. Press as you sew. Make four Rows 1.



Row 1

Step 9: Lay out one each of Units 6, 7, and 8 with two Units 9 as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Units. Sew, RST. Press as you sew. Make four Rows 2.



Row 2

Step 10: Lay out two each Units 5, $3\frac{1}{2}$ " B and I squares with one Unit 1 as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Units. Sew, RST. Press as you sew. Make four Rows 3.



Row 3

Step 11: Sew the rows together, press as you sew. Make four Blocks 4.

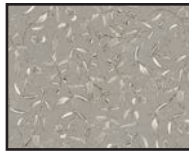

Piecing Instructions

Step 1: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all of the 4" D and S squares. On the S squares, keep all the stripes vertical.



Step 2: Arrange a marked 4" S square with a 4" G square RST. Sew on each side of the diagonal line, 1/4" away from the diagonal line as shown. Cut on the center line. Press both. Trim each to a 3 1/2" square, making sure to center the seam. Make ninety-six Units 1.

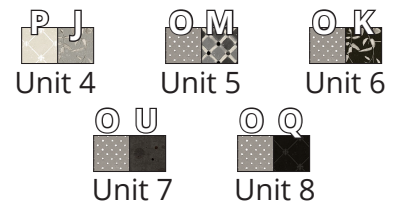


Repeat with a marked 4" D square with a 4" E square. Make sixteen Units 2. Repeat with a marked 4" D square with a 4" F square. Make sixteen Units 3.



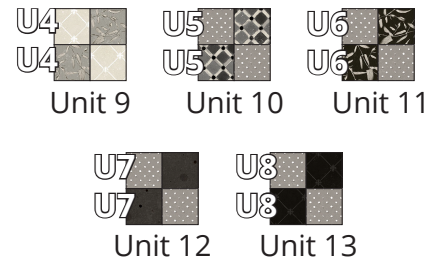
Step 3: Gather all of the 2" squares: J, K, M, O, P, Q, and U. Sew the squares together in pairs as shown, RST. Press.

Make one hundred twenty-eight Units 4 and thirty-two each of Units 5-8. Unit 4: P and J, Unit 5: O and M, Unit 6: O and K, Unit 7: O and U, Unit 8: O and Q

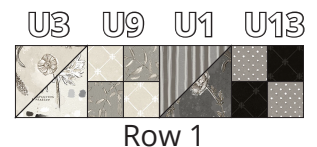


Step 4: Lay out and then sew two Units 4 together as shown, RST. Press. Make sixty-four Units 9.

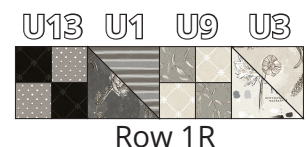
Repeat for Units 5-8. Make sixteen each of Units 10-13.



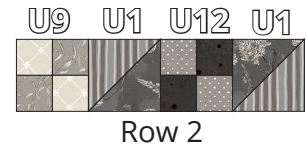
Step 5: Lay out one each of Units 1, 3, 9, and 13 together as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Units. Sew, RST. Press. Make eight Rows 1.



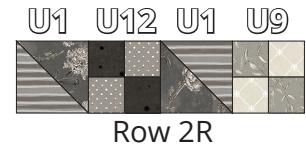
Step 6: Lay out one each of Units 1, 3, 9, and 13 together as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Units. Sew, RST. Press. Make eight Rows 1R.



Step 7: Lay out one each of Units 9, and 12 with two Units 1 as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Units. Sew, RST. Press. Make eight Rows 2.



Step 8: Lay out one each of Units 9, and 12 with two Units 1 as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Units. Sew, RST. Press. Make eight Rows 2R.



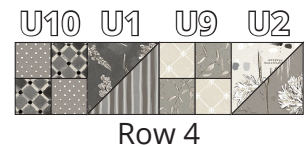
Step 9: Lay out one each of Units 9, and 11 with two Units 1 as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Units. Sew, RST. Press. Make eight Rows 3.



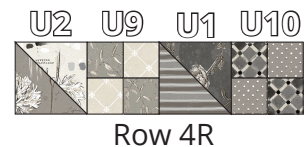
Step 10: Lay out one each of Units 9, and 11 with two Units 1 as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Units. Sew, RST. Press. Make eight Rows 3R.



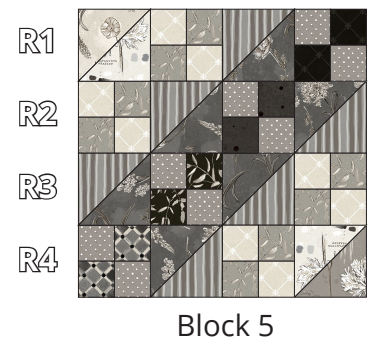
Step 11: Lay out one each of Units 1, 2, 9, and 10 together as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Units. Sew, RST. Press. Make eight Rows 4.



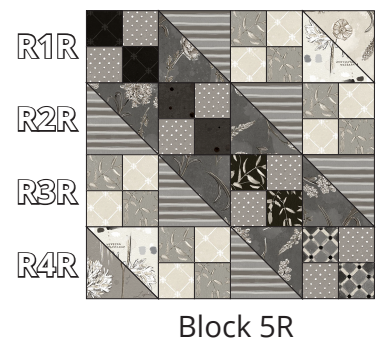

Step 13: Lay out Rows 1a, 2a, 3a, and 4a together as shown. Sew the rows together. Press. Make eight Blocks 5.



Step 14: Lay out Rows 1b, 2b, 3b, and 4b together as shown. Sew the rows together. Press. Make eight Blocks 5R.

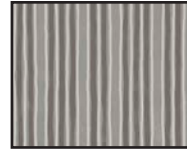

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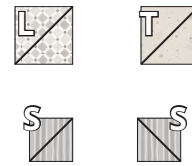

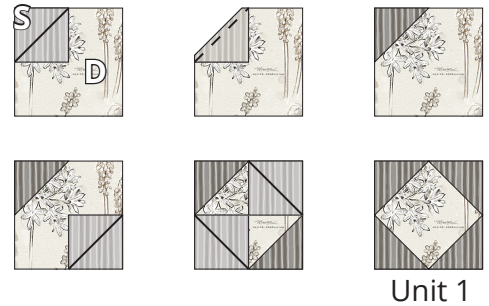

Piecing Instructions

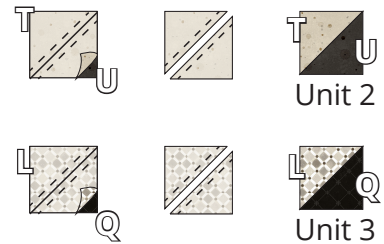
Step 1: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all of the 4½" L and T squares. Arrange all the 3½" S squares wrong side up, making sure the stripes are all vertical. On eight of the squares, draw a diagonal line from the bottom left corner to the top right corner. On the remaining eight squares, draw a diagonal line from the top left to the bottom right.



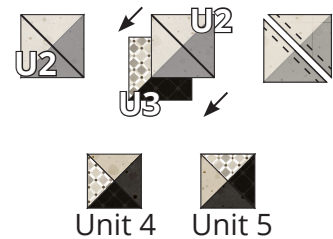
Step 2: Arrange a marked 3½" S square on a corner of a 6½" D square as shown, RST. Make sure the S square stripes are vertical. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press. Repeat for all four corners, making sure to keep all the stripes vertical. Make four Units 1.



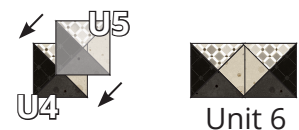
Step 3: Arrange a marked 4½" T square with a 4½" U square RST. Sew on each side of the diagonal line, ¼" away from the diagonal line as shown. Cut on the center line. Press both. Trim each to a 4" square, making sure to center the seam. Make sixteen Units 2. Repeat with a marked 4½" L square and a 4½" Q square. Make sixteen Units 3.



Step 4: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all the Units 2. The line should divide the triangles as shown. Arrange a marked Unit 2 with a Unit 3, as shown, RST. The T triangle should be on top of the L triangle. Sew on each side of the diagonal line, ¼" away from the diagonal line as shown. Cut on the center line. Press both. Trim each to a 3½" square, making sure to center the seam. Make sixteen of each Units 4 and 5.



Step 5: Arrange a Unit 4 with a Unit 5, RST. All the triangles should be lined up, T on top of T, etc. Sew along the T edge. Press. Make sixteen Units 6.



Step 6: Arrange a Unit 1 with four Units 6 and two each 3½" F and G squares as shown. First sew together in rows, RST. Then sew the rows together. Press as you sew. Make two Blocks 6. Arrange the same Units and square, this time changing the placement of the squares as shown. Make two Blocks 6R.

Step 5: Lay out two each Units 4, Units 5, and 3½" I and G squares with a Unit 1 as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Units. First sew in rows, RST. Then sew the rows together. Press as you sew. Make four Blocks 9.

Step 1: Lay out four each Blocks 2 and 3 with one Block 1. Pay close attention to the direction of the blocks and units. Sew together in rows, then sew the rows together. Press as you sew. Make one Center Unit.

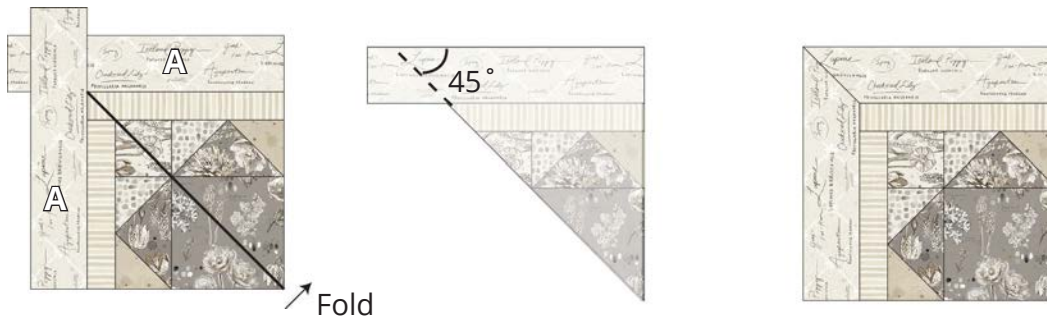


Step 2: Sew a 2" x 36½" R strip to the left side of the Center Unit. Repeat for the right side of the Center Unit. Repeat for the top and bottom, using the 2" x 39½" R strips.

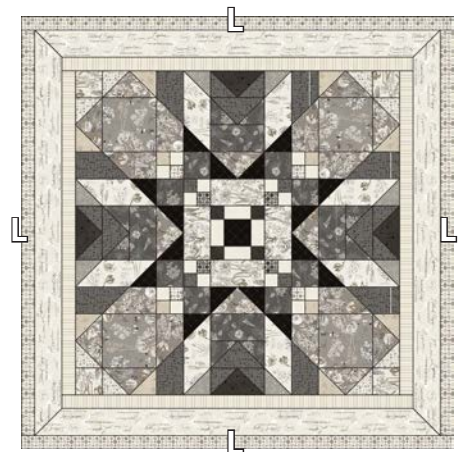


Step 3: Arrange a 3½" x 49" A writing border strip centered on a side of the Quilt. The bottom of the words should face the center. Sew to the Quilt, but stop and backstitch ¼" from each corner, leaving the border ends free. Press, but do not trim yet. Repeat for each side of the Quilt.

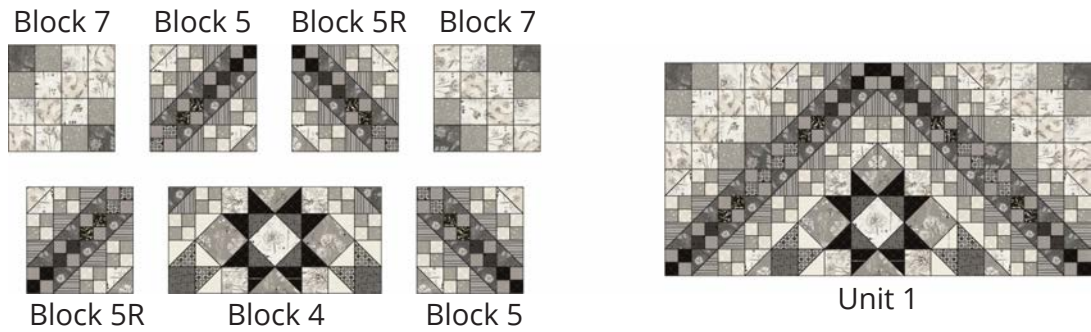
After the borders are stitched on, fold the quilt on the diagonal, right sides together, aligning the raw edges of two adjacent borders. With a ruler, mark a 45 degree line from the point where the stitching stopped on the border to the raw edge of the border. Sew on the 45 degree line, backstitching at both ends. Before trimming to a ¼" seam allowance, check to make sure the corner is sewn correctly. Press. Repeat for each corner.



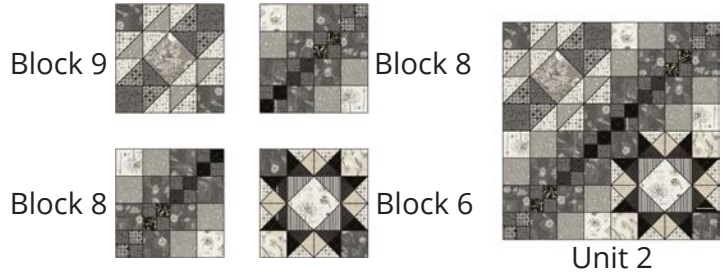
Step 4: Sew two 2" x WOF L strips short ends together. You can measure and cut to 45½" long or use the left side of the quilt to measure and cut your border strip. Sew strip to the left side of the Quilt. Repeat for the right side of the Quilt, using the excess you cut off from the first strip sewn to a 2" x WOF L strip. Repeat for the top and bottom. Either cut the strips to 48½" long or use the top of the quilt to measure and cut.



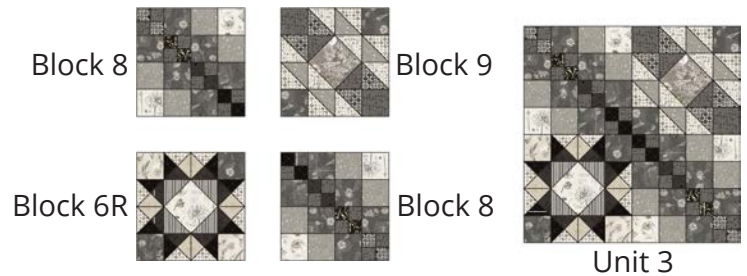
Step 5: Lay out two each Blocks 5, 5R and 7 together with a Block 4 as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the blocks. Sew together in rows and then sew the rows together. Press as you sew. Make four Units 1.



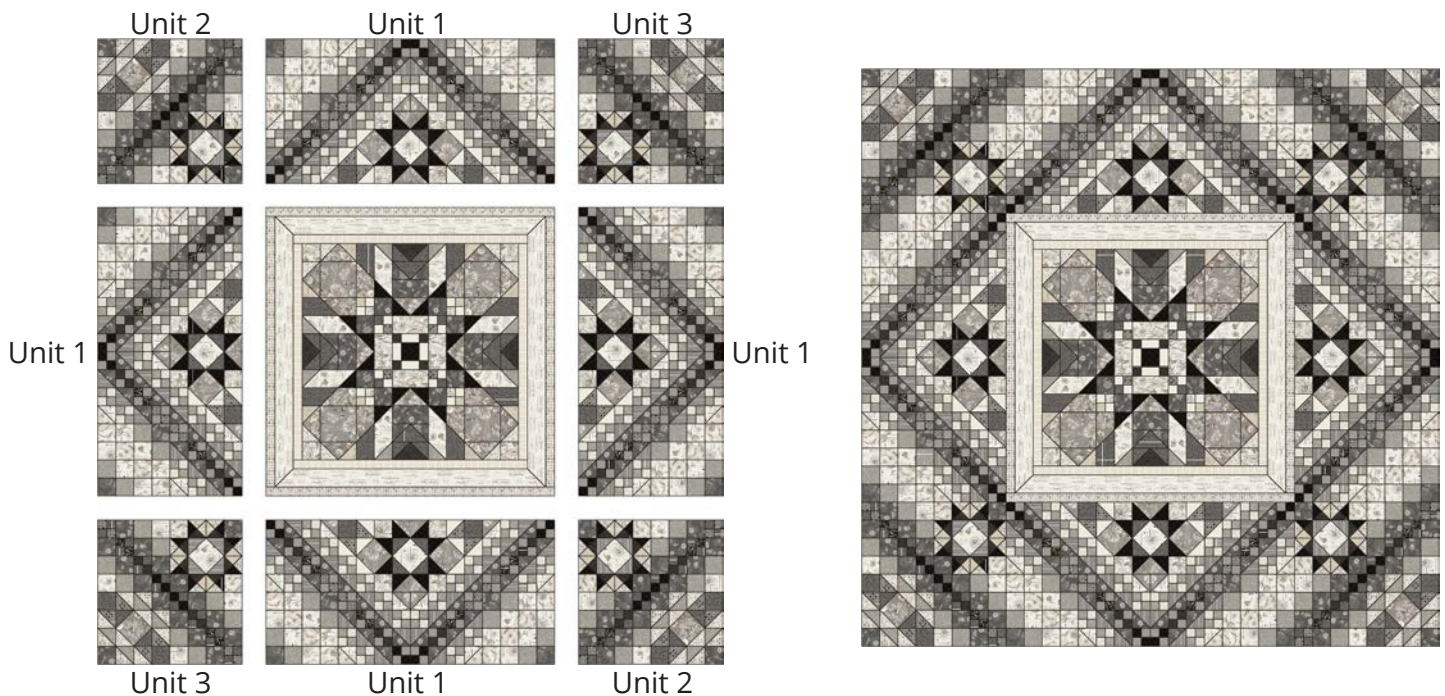
Step 6: Lay out one each Blocks 6 and 9 together with two Blocks 8 as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the blocks. The Block 6 stripes should be vertical. Sew together in rows and then sew the rows together. Press as you sew. Make two Units 2.



Step 7: Lay out one each Blocks 6R and 9 together with two Blocks 8 as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the blocks. The Block 6R stripes should be vertical. Sew together in rows and then sew the rows together. Press as you sew. Make two Units 3.



Step 8: Lay out the center of the quilt with four Units 1 and two each Units 2 and 3 as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the blocks. Make sure the stripes on Units 2 and 3 are vertical. Sew together in rows and then sew the rows together. Press as you sew.



Step 9: Sew three 2" x WOF S strips short ends together. Measure and cut to 96½" long. Using the remaining strip, sew another strip and cut to 96½" long. Sew one 2" x 96½" S strip to the bottom of a 5" x 96½" A Floral strip, with the flowers facing upright. Press. Trim as needed.



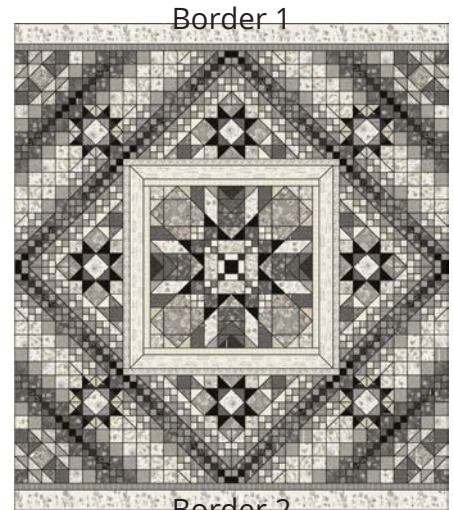

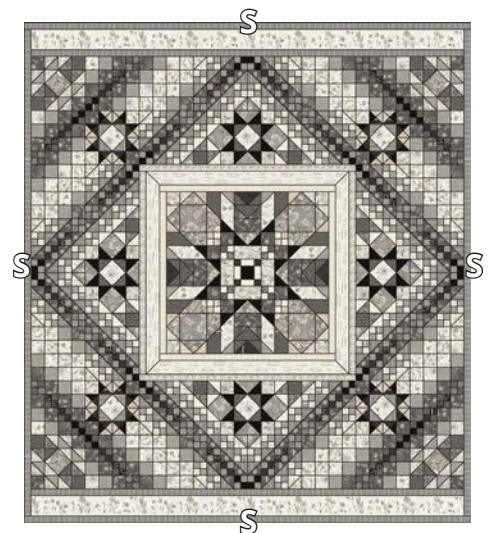
Step 10: Sew the two border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt, so that the flowers are upright and the S strips are facing the quilt center. Press.

Step 11: Sew three 2" x WOF S strips short ends together. You can measure and cut to 108½" long or use the left side of the quilt to measure and cut your border strip. Sew strip to the left side of the Quilt. Repeat for the right side of the Quilt. Repeat for the top and bottom. Use the excess fabric cut from the strips as needed. Either cut the strips to 99½" long or use the top of the quilt to measure and cut.



Step 12: Piece the backing at least 6" larger than the quilt top. Layer the backing wrong side up, the batting and the quilt top. Baste together. Quilt. Before binding, hand baste a scant ¼" around the edge of the quilt to hold the layers together. Piece the binding strips together. Fold the binding in half wrong sides together and press to make a double binding. Sew the binding to the quilt with a ¼", mitering the corners. Trim excess backing and batting and fold the binding over the back side and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
