## Fabric Guide



**Blocks**  
2 Packs of Stamps  
*or*  
(80 - 5" squares)



**Background**  
1 Strip Pack  
*or*  
1¾ yards



**Binding\***  
Included in  
strip pack *or*  
½ yard



**Backing**  
3½ yards

\*Matching binding is included in strip pack fabric, if using yarding or wanting a contract binding, ½ yard of binding fabric is needed.

*Kindly note, our free patterns are not to be sold nor hosted on any other websites. We appreciate your understanding.*

All seam allowances are ¼" unless otherwise stated.  
Press seams open unless otherwise stated.

WOF = Width of Fabric (selvage to selvage)  
RST = Right Sides Together

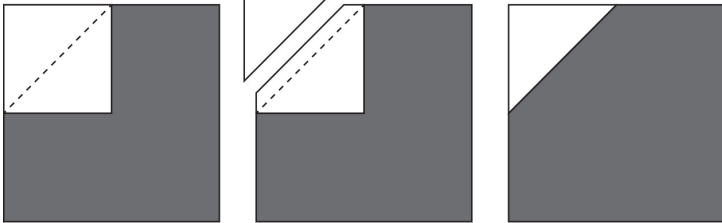
## Cutting Instructions

Blocks	Choose eighty 5" squares - set aside the remaining 4 for another project
Background	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• From 3 strips cut a total of forty 2½" squares</li> <li>• From 9 strips cut a total of thirty-five 2½" x 9½" sashing strips</li> <li>• Sew 3 strips together end-to-end. Cut two 2½" x 50½" strips for horizontal sashing. Make a total of 4 horizontal sashing strips.</li> <li>• Sew 3 strips together end-to-end. Cut two 2½" x 53½" strips for side outer borders.</li> <li>• Sew 3 strips together end-to-end. Cut two 2½" x 54½" strips for top/bottom outer borders.</li> <li>• Set aside 6 strips for binding or see binding below for accent binding.</li> </ul>
Optional Accent Binding	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut 6 strips 2½" x WOF</li> </ul>

# Assembly Instructions

The blocks in the following steps can be whatever combination of 5" squares that you like. Mix and match your fabrics as desired or copy the layout of one of the quilts in the colorstories at the end.

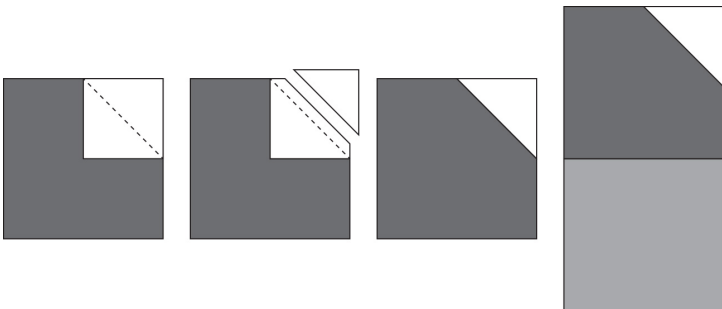
**Step 1:** Gather one 5" x 5" Block square and one 2½" x 2½" background square. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner across the back of the 2½" square. Lay the square in the upper left corner of the 5" square RST as shown and sew along the line. Trim ¼" away from the sewn line as shown and press.



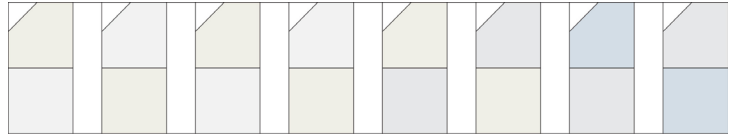
**Step 2:** Sew a different 5" square to the bottom of the block from Step 1. Press. Repeat to make 24 left blocks.



**Step 3:** Repeat Steps 1 & 2 but this time put the 2½" background square in the upper right corner as shown. Repeat to make 16 right blocks.

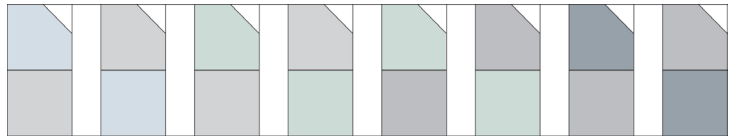


**Step 4:** Gather eight left blocks from Step 2 and seven 2½" x 9½" sashing strips. Lay the blocks out in a row - (either mixing and matching blocks as desired or following the layout of your choosing) - placing a sashing strip between blocks. Sew the row together and press.



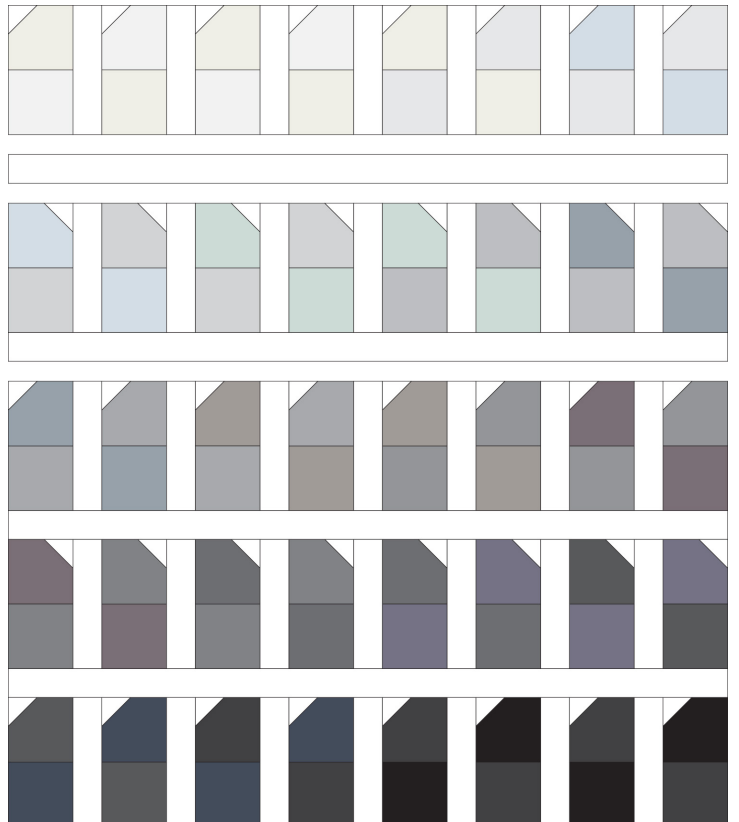
Repeat to make 3 left rows.

**Step 5:** Repeat Step 4 with eight right blocks from Step 3 and seven 2½" x 9½" sashing strips.

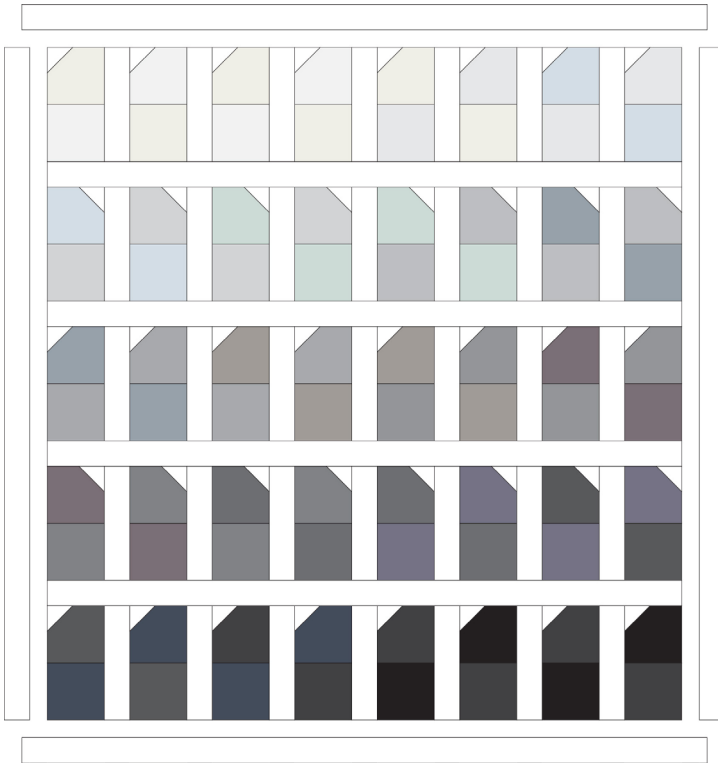


Repeat to make 2 right rows.

**Step 6:** Sew the Rows together in the following order with a horizontal sashing strip between each row. Left Row - Right Row - Left Row - Right Row - Left Row. Press.



# Assembly Instructions



**Step 7:** Sew the side borders to the sides of the quilt top. Press.

**Step 8:** Sew the top and bottom borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press.

**Woohoo!** Your quilt top is finished. Now, quilt and bind it using your preferred method.

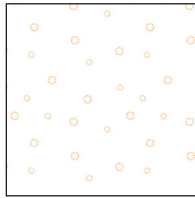

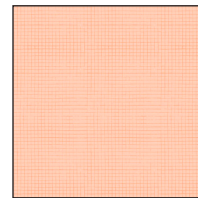
