Step 1: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all of the 3½" M and T squares and all the 4" M squares.



Step 2: Arrange a marked $3\frac{1}{2}$ " M square on a corner of a $6\frac{1}{2}$ " D square as shown, RST. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press. Repeat with marked $3\frac{1}{2}$ " M squares on the remaining corners.
Make one Unit 1.



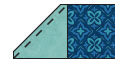

Step 3: Arrange a marked 4" M square with a 4" L square RST. Sew on each side of the diagonal line, $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the diagonal line as shown. Cut on the center line. Press both. Trim each to a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square, making sure to center the seam. Make four Units 2.

Step 4: Arrange a marked $3\frac{1}{2}$ " T square RST on the left side of a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " N rectangle as shown. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press. Repeat on the right side with a marked $3\frac{1}{2}$ " T square as shown.
Make four Units 3.

Step 5: Lay out two Units 2 with one Unit 3 as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Units. Sew, RST. Press as you sew. Make two Rows 1.



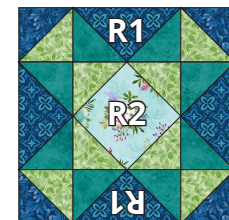

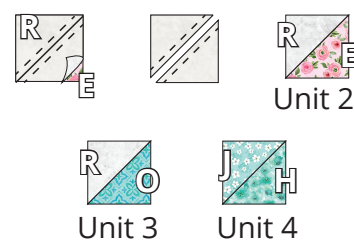
Step 1: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all of the 3½" N squares, 4" G squares, 4½" J and R squares, and on eight of the 4" P squares.



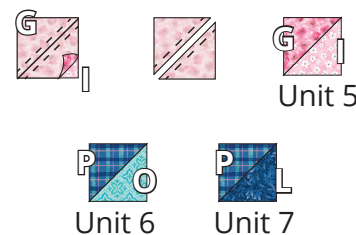
Step 2: Arrange a marked 3½" N square on a corner of a 6½" F square as shown, RST. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press. Repeat for all four corners. Make four Units 1.



Step 3: Arrange a marked 4½" R square with a 4½" E square RST. Sew on each side of the diagonal line, ¼" away from the diagonal line as shown. Cut on the center line. Press both. Trim each to a 4" square, making sure to center the seam. Make four Units 2. Repeat with a marked 4½" R square and a 4½" O square. Make four Units 3. Repeat with a marked 4½" J square and a 4½" H square. Make four Units 4.



Step 4: Arrange a marked 4" G square with a 4" I square RST. Sew on each side of the diagonal line, ¼" away from the diagonal line as shown. Cut on the center line. Press both. Trim each to a 3½" square, making sure to center the seam. Make eight Units 5. Repeat with a marked 4" P square and a 4" O square. Make eight Units 6. Repeat with a marked 4" P square and a 4" L square. Make eight Units 7.



Step 5: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all the Units 2. The line should divide the triangles as shown. Arrange a marked Unit 2 with a 4" I square, as shown, RST. Sew on each side of the diagonal line, ¼" away from the diagonal line as shown. Cut on the center line. Press both. Trim each to a 3½" square, making sure to center the seam. Make four of each Units 8 and 9.



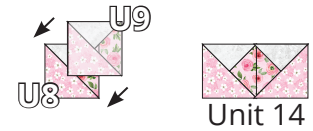
Repeat, marking a Unit 3 and sewing to a 4" I square. Make four each Units 10 and 11.



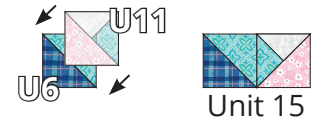
Repeat, marking a Unit 4 and sewing to a 4" P square. Make four each Units 12 and 13.



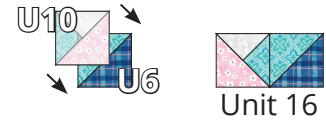
Step 6: Arrange a Unit 8 with a Unit 9, RST. All the triangles should be lined up, E on top of E, etc. Sew along the E edge. Press. Make four Units 14.



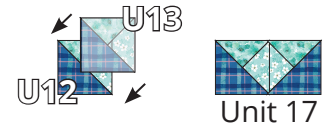
Step 7: Arrange a Unit 11 with a Unit 6, RST, as shown. The I triangle should be on top of the P triangle. Sew along the small O triangle edge. Press. Make two Units 15.



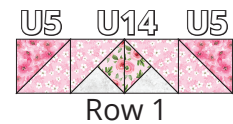
Repeat with a Unit 10 with a Unit 6, RST, as shown. Make two Units 16.



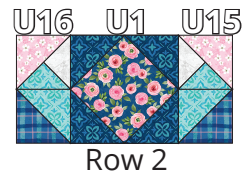
Step 8: Arrange a Unit 12 with a Unit 13, RST. All the triangles should be lined up, J on top of J, etc. Sew along the J edge. Press. Make four Units 17.



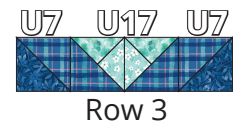
Step 9: Lay out two Units 5 with one Unit 14 as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Units. Sew, RST. Press as you sew. Make four Rows 1.



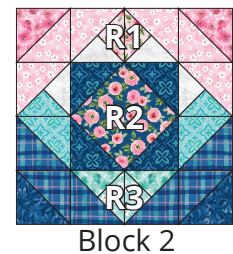
Step 10: Lay out one each Units 15 and 16 with one Unit 1 as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Units. Sew, RST. Press as you sew. Make four Row 2.



Step 11: Lay out two Units 7 with one Unit 17 as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Units. Sew, RST. Press as you sew. Make four Rows 3.



Step 12: Lay out one each Rows 1-3 as shown. Sew the rows, RST. Press as you sew. Make four Blocks 2.

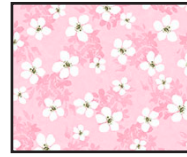

Step 1: Sew a 2" I square to a 2" T square, RST. Press. Make eight Units 1.
Sew two Units 1 together as shown, RST. Press. Make four Units 2.

Step 2: Sew a 2" T square to the short end of a 2" x 3½" G rectangle, as shown, RST. Press. Make four Units 3.

Step 3: Sew a 2" x 3½" G rectangle to a Unit 2, as shown, RST. Press. Make four Units 4.

Step 4: Sew a Unit 3 to a Unit 4, as shown, RST. Press. Make four Units 5.



Step 5: Sew a 2 3/8" T HST to a 2" I square as shown. Sew a 2 3/8" T HST to the adjacent side of the I square as shown, RST. Press. Make sixteen Units 6.



Step 6: Sew a 2 3/8" T HST to the short end of a 2" x 3 1/2" G rectangle as shown, RST. Press. Make eight Units 7. Repeat with a 2 3/8" T HST sewn to the opposite short end of a 2" x 3 1/2" G rectangle as shown, RST. Press. Make eight Units 8.



Step 7: Sew a Unit 6 to a Unit 7, as shown, RST. Press. Make eight Units 9. Repeat with a Unit 6 and Unit 8 as shown. Make eight Units 10.



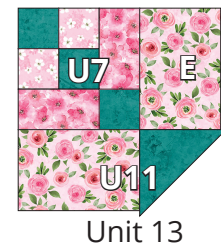
Step 8: Sew a 3 7/8" T HST to the short end of a 3 1/2" x 5" E rectangle as shown, RST. Press. Make four Units 11.



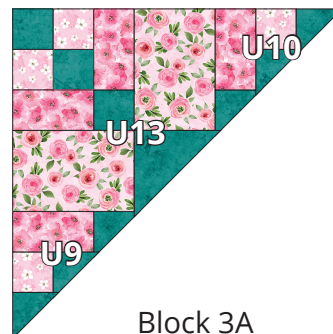
Step 9: Arrange a 4 1/4" T QST centered on the short end of a 3 1/2" x 5" E rectangle as shown. Sew, RST. Press. Make four Units 12.



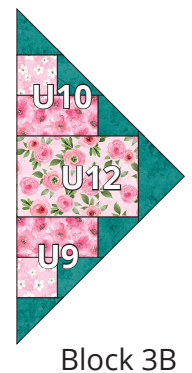
Step 10: First sew a 3 1/2" x 5" E rectangle to the right side of Unit 5 as shown, RST. Press. Then sew a Unit 11 to the bottom, lining up the left edge as shown. Press. Make four Units 13.



Step 11: Arrange a Unit 9 on the bottom and a Unit 10 on the right side of Unit 13 as shown, lining up the top and left edges. Sew, RST. Press. Make four Blocks 3A.



Step 12: Arrange a Unit 10 on the top and a Unit 9 on the bottom of Unit 12 as shown, lining up the left edges. Sew, RST. Press. Make four Blocks 3B.

Step 3: Arrange a marked 2½" M square on the Q corner of a Unit 1 as shown, RST. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press. Repeat with a marked 2½" T square on the J corner as shown. Make sixteen Units 2.



Step 4: Arrange two Units 2, RST. All the fabrics should be lined up, T on top of T, etc. Sew along the J and T edge. Press. Make eight Units 3.



Step 5: Arrange a marked 2½" J square on a corner of a 4½" T square as shown, RST. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press. Make sixteen Units 4.



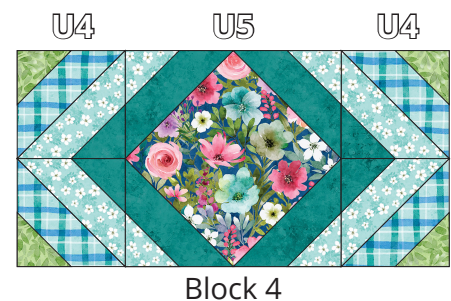
Step 6: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all of the Units 4. Make sure the line is parallel to the J corner triangles as shown.



Step 7: Arrange a marked Unit 4 on a corner of a 8½" B square shown, RST. Make sure the C triangle is pointing toward the center of the block. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press. Repeat on all the corners. Make four Units 5.



Step 8: Lay out two Units 4 with one Unit 5 as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the Units. Sew, RST. Press as you sew. Make four Blocks 4.

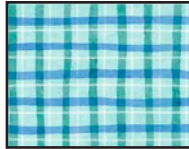

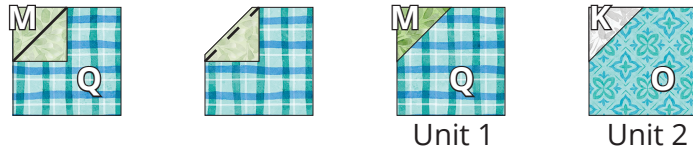

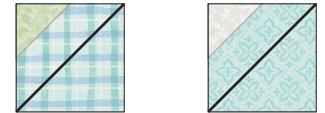

Step 4: Arrange a marked Unit 1 on the top left corner of a $8\frac{1}{2}$ " C square shown, RST. Make sure the C triangle is pointing toward the center of the block. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press.



Repeat with a Unit 1 on the bottom left corner.

Piecing Instructions

Step 1: Lay out four each Blocks 2, 3A and 3B with one Block 1. Pay close attention to the direction of the blocks and units. Sew together in rows, then sew the rows together. Press as you sew. Make one Center Unit.



Step 2: Sew a 1½" x WOF" T strip to the left side of the Center Unit. It will be longer than the side. Press and trim to the length of the quilt. Repeat for the right side of the Center Unit. Repeat for the top and bottom, using the 1½" x WOF T strips. Trim the quilt center to a 36½" x 36½" square, trimming the edges equally to center the block.



Step 3: Measure and cut two 2½" x WOF O strips to 36½" or use the left side of the quilt to measure and cut your border strip. Sew the strips to the left and right side of the quilt. Press. Repeat for the top and bottom. Either cutting the strips to 40½" long or use the top of the quilt to measure and cut.

Step 4: Measure and cut two 3" x WOF D strips to 40½" or use the left side of the quilt to measure and cut your border strip. Sew the strips to the left and right side of the quilt. Press. Sew two 3" x WOF D strips short ends together. You can measure and cut to 45½" long or use the top of the quilt to measure and cut your border strip. Sew strip to the top of the Quilt. Repeat for the bottom of the Quilt, using the scrap from the first strip sewn to a 3" x WOF D strip.

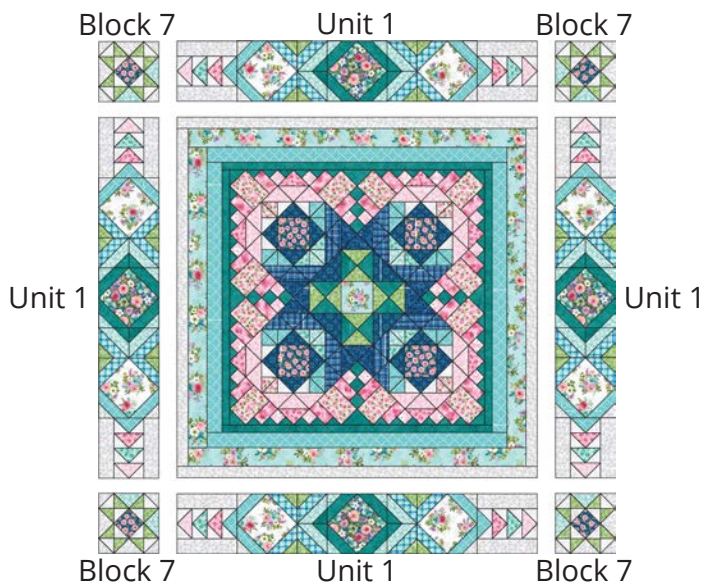
Step 5: Sew two 2" x WOF K strips short ends together. You can measure and cut to 45½" long or use the left side of the quilt to measure and cut your border strip. Sew strip to the left side of the Quilt. Repeat for the right side of the Quilt, using the scrap from the first strip sewn to a 2" x WOF K strip. Repeat for the top and bottom. Either cut the strips to 48½" long or use the top of the quilt to measure and cut. Use the scraps from the side borders as needed.



Step 6: Sew two each Blocks 5 and 6 together with a Block 4 as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the blocks. Press. Make four Units 1.



Step 7: Lay out the Center Unit with four each of Units 1 and Blocks 7 as shown. The J triangles on Blocks 7 should be facing the center. Sew together in rows, then sew the rows together. Press as you sew.



Step 8: Sew two 2" x WOF R strips short ends together. Measure and cut to 64½" long or use the left side of the quilt to measure and cut your border strip. Sew to the left side of the quilt. Press. Repeat for the right side. Press. Repeat, using the 2½" x WOF R strips for the top and bottom. Either cut the strips to 67½" long or use the top of the quilt to measure and cut.

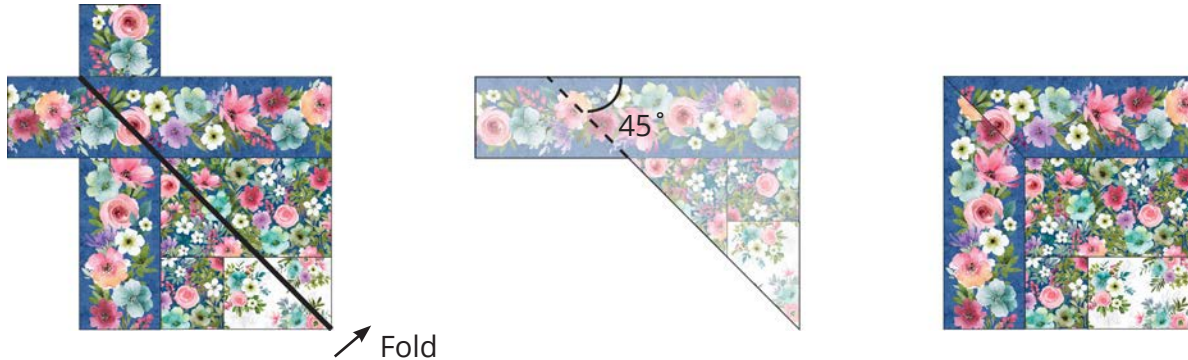
Step 9: Sew two 3" x WOF C strips short ends together. Measure and cut to 68½" long or use the left side of the quilt to measure and cut your border strip. Sew to the left side of the quilt. Press. Repeat for the right side. Press. Repeat, using the 4½" x WOF C strips for the top and bottom. Either cut the strips to 72½" long or use the top of the quilt to measure and cut.

Step 10: Sew two 4" x WOF B strips short ends together. Measure and cut to 76½" long or use the left side of the quilt to measure and cut your border strip. Sew to the left side of the quilt. Press. Repeat for the the right side. Press. Repeat, using the 6" x WOF B strips for the top and bottom. Either cut the strips to 79½" long or use the top of the quilt to measure and cut.



Step 11: Arrange a 5" x LOF" A floral border strip centered on a side of the Quilt. Sew to the Quilt, but stop and backstitch ¼" from each corner, leaving the border ends free. Press, but do not trim yet. Repeat for the opposite side of the Quilt.

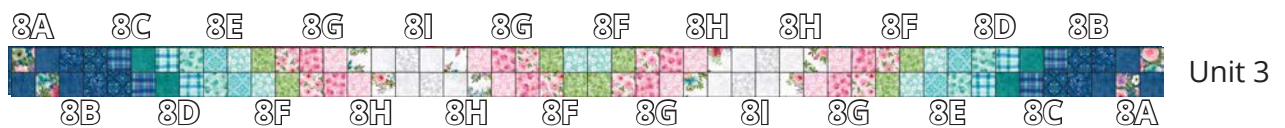
In the same way, sew a 5" x 92" A floral border strip centered on a top and bottom of the Quilt. After the borders are stitched on, fold the quilt on the diagonal, right sides together, aligning the raw edges of two adjacent borders. With a ruler, mark a 45 degree line from the point where the stitching stopped on the border to the raw edge of the border. Sew on the 45 degree line, backstitching at both ends. Before trimming to a ¼" seam allowance, check to make sure the corner is sewn correctly. Press. Repeat for each corner.



Step 12: Sew two each Blocks 8B, 8C, 8D, and 8I together with four each Blocks 8E, 8F, 8G, and 8H as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the blocks. Press. Make two Unit 2.



Step 13: Sew two each Blocks 8A, 8B, 8C, 8D, 8E, and 8I together with four each Blocks 8F, 8G, and 8H as shown. Pay close attention to the direction of the blocks. Press. Make two Unit 2.



Step 14: Sew the Units 2 to the left and right sides of the quilt. Press. Pay close attention to the direction of the Units.

Sew the Units 3 to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press. Pay close attention to the direction of the Units.

Step 15: Piece the backing at least 6" larger than the quilt top. Layer the backing wrong side up, the batting and the quilt top. Baste together. Quilt. Before binding, hand baste a scant ¼" around the edge of the quilt to hold the layers together. Piece the binding strips together. Fold the binding in half wrong sides together and press to make a double binding. Sew the binding to the quilt with a ¼", mitering the corners. Trim excess backing and batting and fold the binding over the back side and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
