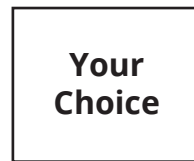

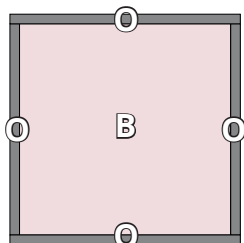

Cutting Instructions

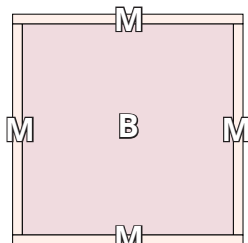

| A | 4 - 8¾" x LOF (fussy cut the stripes as shown in the quilt image) |
| B | 5 - 11½" squares (fussy cut) |
| C | 4 - 6½" squares |
| D | 4 - 6½" squares |
| E | 1 - 3½" x WOF strip, cut into 12 - 3½" squares |
| F | 3 - 2" x WOF strips, cut into 48 - 2" squares |
| G | 3 - 2" x WOF strips, cut one strip in half |
| H | 3 - 2" x WOF strips, cut one strip in half |
| I | 4 - 3½" squares 8 - 2" squares |
| J | 2 - 2" x WOF strips cut into 24 - 2" squares |
| K | 2 - 2" x WOF strips, cut one strip in half |
| L | 2 - 2" x WOF strips, cut one strip in half |
| M | 2 - 1" x WOF strips cut into 2 - 1" x 11½" strips and 2 - 1" x 12½" strips 4 - 2" x WOF strips, cut one strip in half 8 - 2" x WOF strips, cut into: 72 - 2" x 3½" strips 8 - 2" x 5½" strips 4 - 3½" x WOF strips, cut into 32 - 3½" x 5" strips |
| N | 6 - 2" x WOF strips cut into 72 - 2" x 3½" strips |
| O | 6 - 1" x WOF strips cut into 8 - 1" x 11½" strips and 8 - 1" x 12½" strips 4 - 2" x WOF strips, cut one strip in half 1 - 2" x WOF strip, cut into 8 - 2" x 5" strips 4 - 3½" x WOF strips, cut into 32 - 3½" x 5" strips |

Piecing Instructions

Step 1: Sew a 1" x 11½" O strip to the left and right sides of a 11½" B square, as shown, RST. Press. Sew a 1" x 12½" O strip to the top and bottom of the same 11½" B square, as shown, RST. Press. Make four Blocks 1. Repeat with the 1" M strips on a 11½" B square. Make one Block 2. (Refer to the quilt when choosing the B center for Block 2.)

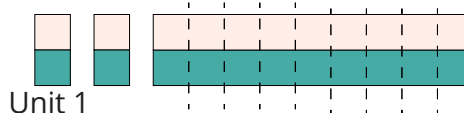

Step 2: Sew a 2" x WOF G strip to a 2" x WOF M strip along the long edge. Press. Repeat with one each 2" x WOF G and M half strips. Make two and half strip sets.

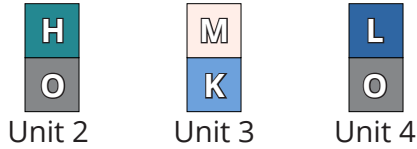


Cut the GM strip sets every 2" to make 2" x 3½" units, as shown. Make forty-eight Units 1.



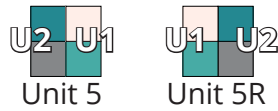
Unit 1

Step 3: Repeat Step 2 with two and a half 2" x WOF H&O, and one and a half K&M, and L&O strips. Make forty-eight Units 2. Make twenty-four each of Units 3 and 4.

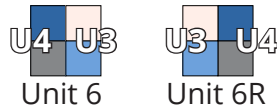


Step 4: Sew a Unit 1 to the right side of a Unit 2 as shown. Press. Make twenty-four Units 5.

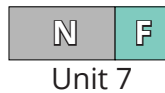
Repeat with the Unit 1 on the left side of a Unit 2 as shown. Make twenty-four Units 5R.



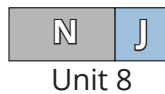
Step 5: Repeat Step 4 with the Units 3 and 4, making twelve each Units 6 and 6R.



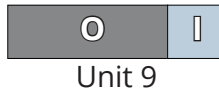
Step 6: Sew a 2" F square to the short end of a 2" x 3½" N strip as shown. Press. Make forty-eight Units 7.



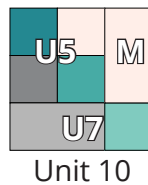
Repeat with a 2" J square and a 2" x 3½" N strip. Make twenty-four Units 8.



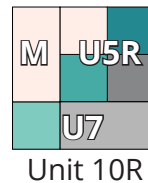
Repeat with a 2" I square and a 2" x 5" O strip. Make eight Units 9.



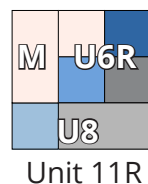
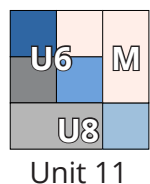
Step 7: Sew a 2" x 3½" M strip to the right side of a Unit 5, as shown. Press. Sew a Unit 7 to the bottom as shown. Press. Make twenty-four Units 10.



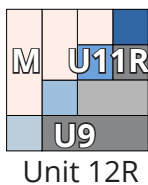
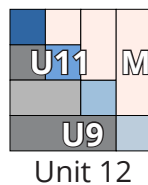
Step 8: Sew a 2" x 3½" M strip to the left side of a Unit 5R. Press. Sew a Unit 7 to the bottom as shown. Press. Make twenty-four Units 10R.



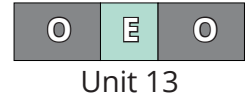
Step 9: Repeat Steps 7 and 8 with the Units 6, 6R, 8 and 2" x 3½" M strips as shown. Make twelve each Units 11 and 11R.



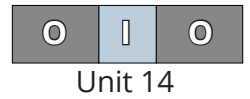
Step 10: Repeat Steps 7 and 8 with the Units 11, 11R, 9 and 2" x 5" M strips as shown. Make four each Units 12 and 12R.



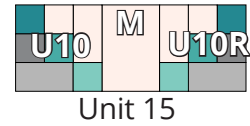
Step 11: Sew together two 3½" x 5" O strips with one 3½" E square, as shown. Press. Make twelve Units 13.



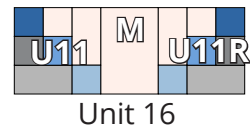
Step 12: Sew together two 3½" x 5" O strips with one 3½" I square. Press. Make four Units 14.



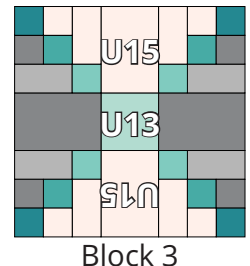
Step 13: Sew together one each Units 10 and 10R with one 3½" x 5" M strip, as shown. Press. Make twenty-four Units 15.



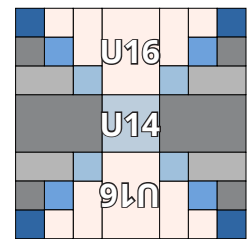
Step 14: Sew together one each Units 11 and 11R with one 3½" x 5" M strip, as shown. Press. Make eight Units 16.



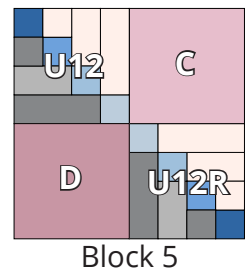
Step 15: Sew two Units 15 with one Unit 13 as shown. The second Unit 15 will be rotated 180°. Press. Make twelve Blocks 3.



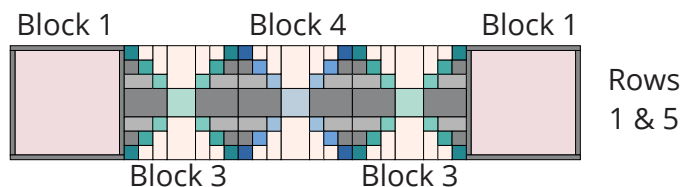
Step 16: Sew two Units 16 with one Unit 14 as shown. The second Unit 16 will be rotated 180°. Press. Make four Blocks 4.



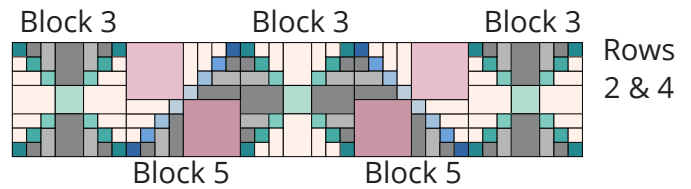
Step 17: Lay out one each 6½" C and D squares with one each Units 12 and 12R, as shown. Sew together in rows and then sew the rows together. Press as you sew. Make four Blocks 5. (If the direction of the C and D blocks is important, refer to the quilt image when laying out the blocks.)



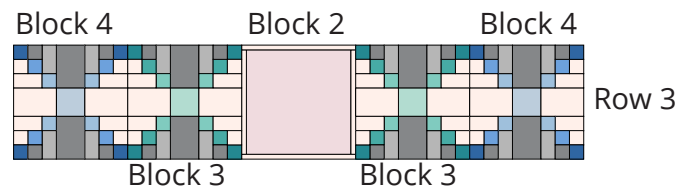
Step 18: Lay out two each Blocks 1 and 3 with one Block 4 as shown. Sew together. Press as you sew. Make two total, Rows 1 and 5.



Step 19: Lay out three Blocks 3 with two Blocks 5 as shown. Sew together. Press as you sew. Make two total, Rows 2 and 4. (Row 4 will be rotated 180°. Keep this in mind when laying out the blocks.)



Step 20: Lay out two each Blocks 3 and 4 with the Block 2 as shown. Sew together. Press as you sew. Make one Row 3.



Step 21: Lay out all the Rows 1 - 5, as shown. Sew all the rows together. Press as you sew.

Step 22: Sew two 1¾" x WOF P strips short sides together. Trim to 60½" long. Repeat to make two total 1¾" x 60½" P strips.

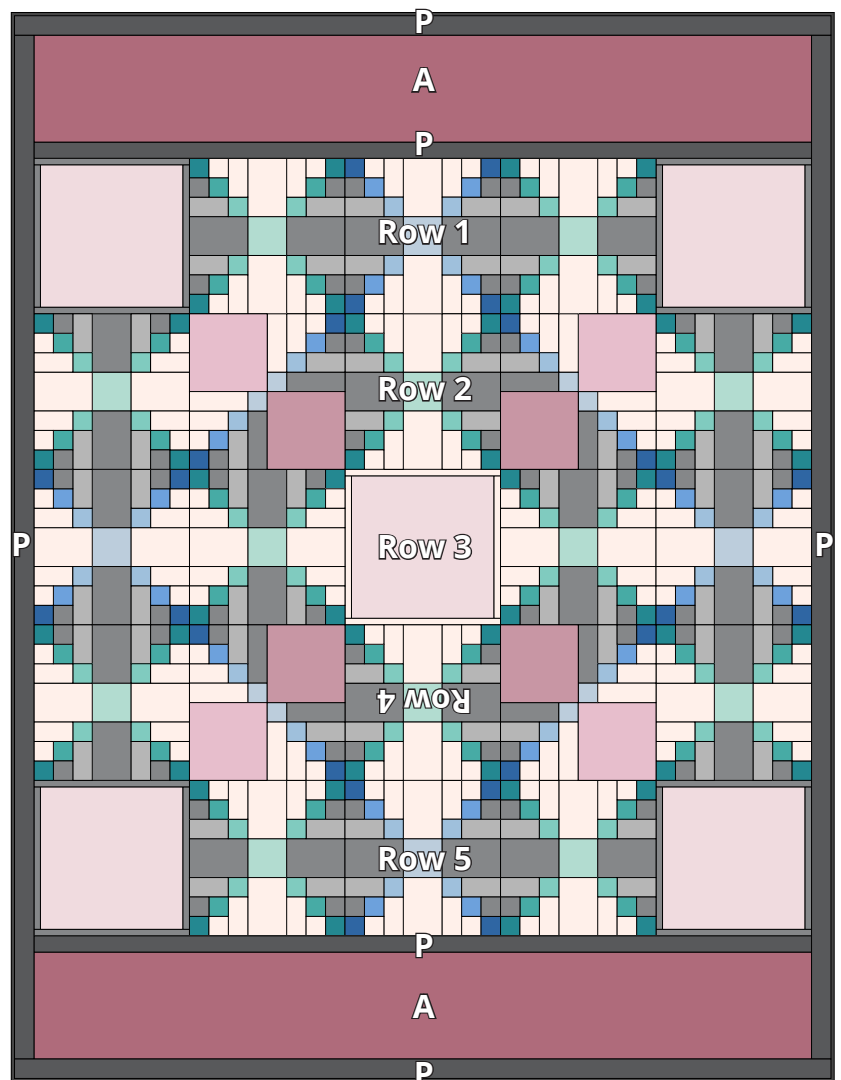
Sew two 8¾" x LOF A fussy cut strips short sides together, lining up the stripes. Trim to 60½" long. Repeat to make two 8¾" x 60½" A strips.

Sew a 1¾" x 60½" P strip to the bottom of a 1¾" x 60½" A strip as shown in the quilt image.

Repeat, sewing a P strip to the top of an A strip as shown in the quilt image. Sew the joined strips to the top and bottom of the quilt as shown, with the P strips sewn to the quilt center.

Step 23: Sew two 2" x WOF P strips short sides together. Trim to 79½" long or use the left side of the quilt to measure and cut your border strip. Sew strip to the left side of the Quilt. Press. Repeat for the right side of the Quilt. Repeat for the top and bottom of the Quilt, trimming to 63½" or using the bottom of the quilt to measure and cut.

Step 24: Piece the backing at least 6" larger than the quilt top. Layer the backing wrong side up, the batting and the quilt top. Baste together. Quilt. Before binding, hand baste a scant ¼" around the edge of the quilt to hold the layers together. Piece the binding strips together. Fold the binding in half wrong sides together and press to make a double binding. Sew the binding to the quilt with a ¼" seam allowance, mitering the corners. Trim excess backing and batting and fold the binding over the back side and stitch down by hand with matching thread.

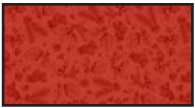

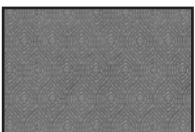
