WOF = Width of Fabric (selvage to selvage)


RST = Right Sides Together

## Cutting Instructions


Fabric A	Cut one 10½" x 10½" square
Fabrics B, C, E & F	Cut one strip 3" x WOF - subcut one 3" x 3" square
Fabrics D, H, I, K, L & M	Cut one strip 3" x WOF - subcut two 3" x 3" squares
Fabrics G & J	Cut one strip 3" x WOF - subcut four 3" x 3" squares
Fabric N	Cut one strip 2½" x WOF - subcut eight 2½" x 2½" squares and four 2½" x 4½" rectangles Cut two strips 3" x WOF - subcut twenty-four 3" x 3" squares Cut two strips 1½" x WOF - subcut two 1½" x 10½" strips and two 1½" x 12½" strips
Binding	Cut three strips 2½" x WOF

## Piecing Instructions

**Step 1:** Draw a diagonal line on the back of a 3" x 3" Fabric N square. Lay it RST on top of a 3" x 3" Fabric B square. Stitch a scant ¼" away from either side of the line. Cut apart on drawn line to create two B/N HSTs. Open up block and press. Square up to 2½" x 2½".



Repeat to make the listed number of blocks in each fabric combination:






**Step 2:** To make a side border, gather the following pieces:

- 1 - 2½" x 4½" Fabric N rectangles
- 1 - D/N HSTs
- 2 - G/N HSTs
- 1 - J/N HSTs
- 1 - M/N HSTs
- 2 - L/N HSTs
- 1 - F/N HSTs
- 1 - I/N HSTs
- 1 - C/N HSTs

Lay the blocks out as shown making sure to pay attention to placement and rotation of blocks.

Sew together and then Press.

Repeat to make a second side border.



## Piecing Instructions


**Step 3:** To make a top border, gather the following pieces:

- 4 - 2½" x 2½" Fabric N squares
- 1 - 2½" x 4½" Fabric N rectangles
- 3 - J/N HSTs
- 1 - A/N HSTs
- 2 - H/N HSTs
- 2 - K/N HSTs
- 1 - E/N HST
- 1 - M/N HST
- 2 - G/N HST
- 1 - D/N HST
- 1 - I/N HST

Lay the blocks out as shown making sure to pay attention to placement and rotation of blocks.

Sew together and then Press.

Repeat to make a second bottom border.




**Step 4:** Sew the 1½" x 10½" Fabric N strip to either side of the 10½" x 10½" Fabric A square. Press.

**Step 5:** Sew the 1½" x 12½" Fabric N strip to either side of the topper from step 4. Press.



**Step 6:** Sew the side border from Step 2 to either side of the topper, making sure to pay attention to the rotation of the border. Press.

**Step 7:** Sew the top and bottom border from Step 3 to the top and bottom of the topper, making sure to pay attention to the rotation of the border. Press.



**Woohoo!** Your table topper is finished. Now, quilt and bind using your preferred method.
