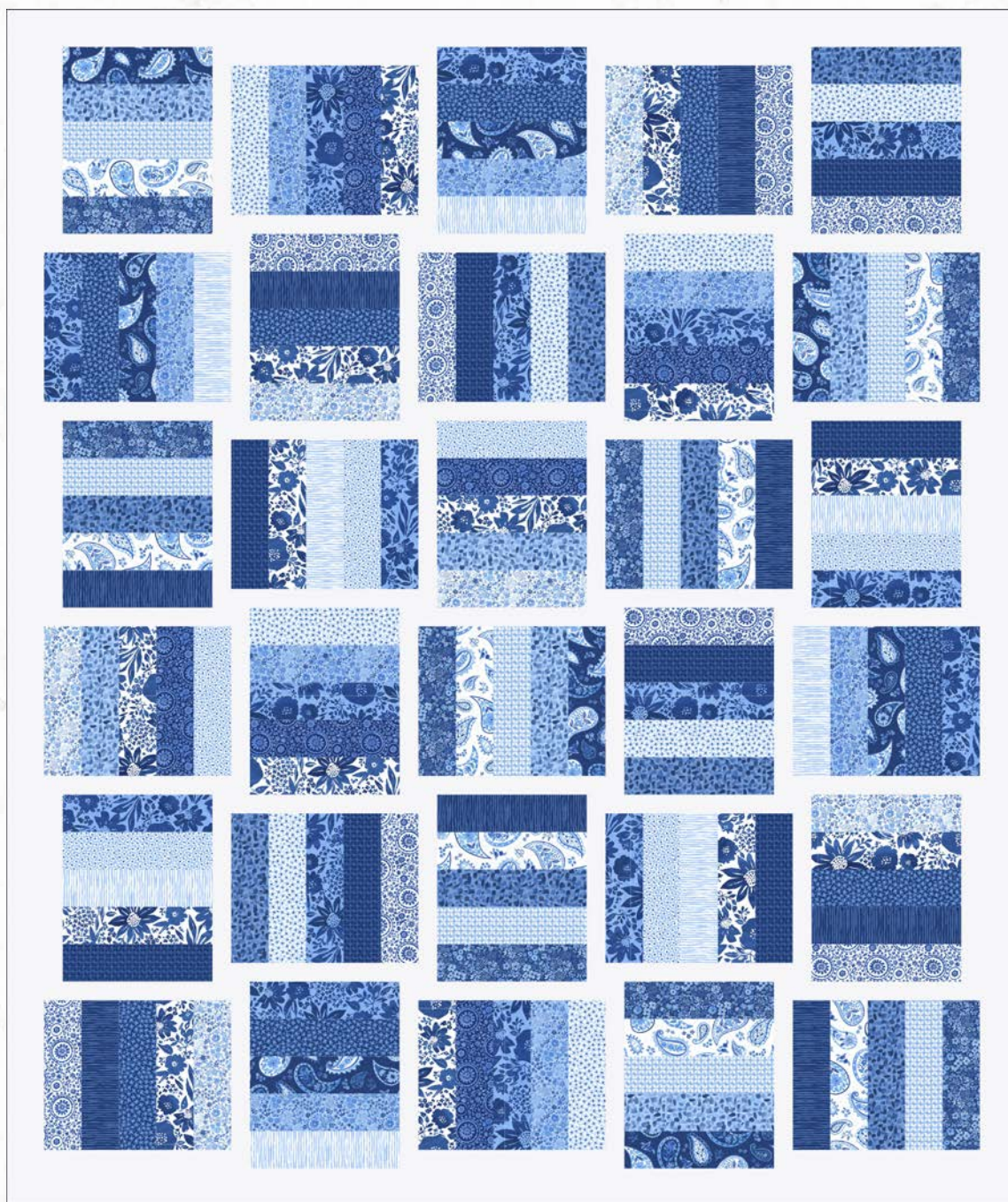

Finished size: 54" x 64"

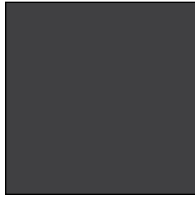

Fabric Guide



Fabric A
1 Strip Pack



Fabric B
1 yard



Binding
 $\frac{5}{8}$ yard



Backing
 $3\frac{1}{2}$ yards

Kindly note, our free patterns are not to be sold nor hosted on any other websites. We appreciate your understanding.

Fabric Requirements assume 42" of usable fabric.
All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " unless otherwise stated.

Press seams open unless otherwise stated.
WOF = Width of Fabric (selvage to selvage)

Cutting Instructions

Fabric B	Cut 15 strips $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF - Subcut strips into a total of 60 strips $1\frac{1}{2}$" x $10\frac{1}{2}$" Cut 6 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF - Sew strips together end-to-end to create one long strip, from the resulting strip cut 2 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$" x $60\frac{1}{2}$" for side borders and 2 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$" x $54\frac{1}{2}$" for top and bottom borders
Binding	Cut 7 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF

Assembly Instructions

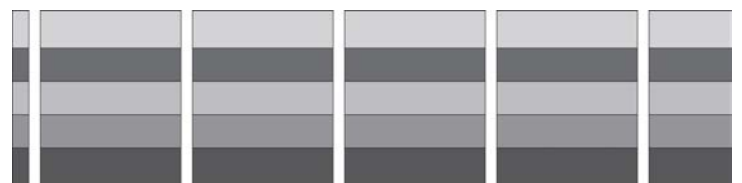
The blocks in the following steps can be whatever combination of strips that you like. Mix and match your fabrics as desired or copy the layout of one of the quilts in the colorstories at the end.

Step 1: Gather five $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric A strips. Lay them out in the order you like and then sew them all together the long way to create a strip set. Press seams open or to one side.



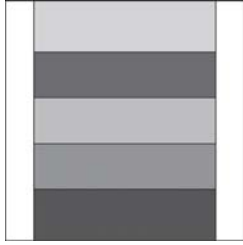
Repeat with all fabric A strips to create a total of 8 strip sets.

Cut each strip set into four $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks for a total of 32 blocks - set 2 blocks aside for another project.



Assembly Instructions

Step 2: Sew a 1½" x 10½" Fabric B strip to both sides of a block from Step 1. Press.



Repeat for all 30 blocks.

Step 3: Arrange blocks in a 5x6 grid, rotating every other block as shown below.

Once you have a layout you like, sew the blocks into rows. Press.



Sew the rows together. Press.

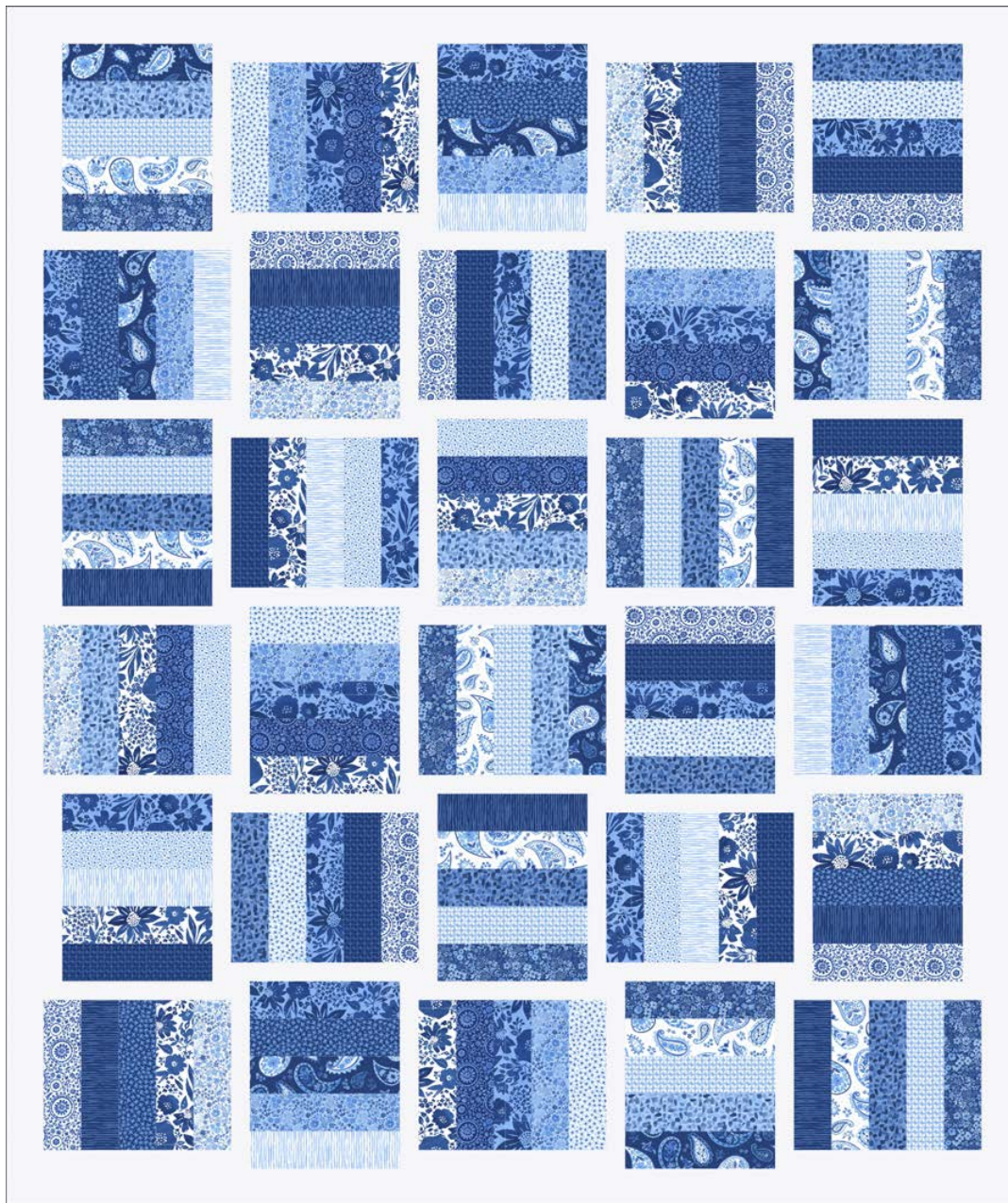
Step 4: Sew the Fabric B Side border to the sides of the quilt top. Press

Sew the Fabric B top and bottom borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press.



Woohoo! Your quilt top is finished. Now, quilt and bind using your preferred method.

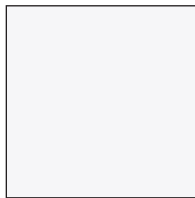

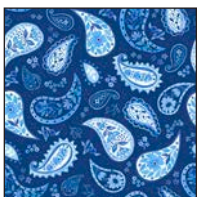
