Press seams open unless otherwise stated.

WOF = Width of Fabric (selvage to selvage)

Cutting Instructions

Fabric A	Fussy cut 3 panels 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
Fabric B	Cut two strips 1" x WOF • Subcut 2 strips 1" x 18$\frac{1}{2}$" and 2 strips 1" x 11$\frac{1}{2}$" for panel borders Cut one strip 2" x WOF • Subcut 4 squares 2" x 2" for cornerstones
Fabric C	Cut 4 strips 1" x WOF • Subcut 4 strips 1" x 18$\frac{1}{2}$" and 4 strips 1" x 11$\frac{1}{2}$" for panel borders Cut one strip 2" x WOF • Subcut 12 squares 2" x 2" for cornerstones
Fabric D	Cut 4 strips 2" x WOF - sew strips together end-to-end to create one long strip • Subcut 4 strips 2" x 18$\frac{1}{2}$" and 6 strips 2" x 12$\frac{1}{2}$" for sashing
Fabric E	Cut 4 strips 2" x WOF - sew strips together end-to-end to create one long strip • Subcut 2 strips 2" x 42$\frac{1}{2}$" and 2 strips 2" x 21$\frac{1}{2}$" for inner border
Fabric F	Cut 4 strips 2" x WOF - sew strips together end-to-end to create one long strip • Subcut 2 strips 2" x 45$\frac{1}{2}$" and 2 strips 2" x 24$\frac{1}{2}$" for outer border

Piecing Instructions

Step 1: To make an AB block, sew the 1" x 11½" Fabric B strips to the left and right sides of a 17½" x 11½" Fabric A panel. Press. Sew the 1" x 18½" Fabric B strips to the top of the panel. Press.



Step 2: Repeat Step 1 with Fabric C strips and 2 more Fabric A Panels to make 2 AC blocks.



Step 3: Sew a 2" x 2" Fabric B square to both sides of a 2" x 18½" Fabric D strip. Press. Repeat to make a second BD strip.



Step 4: Sew a 2" x 2" Fabric C square to both sides of a 2" x 18½" Fabric D strip. Press. Repeat to make a second CD strip.

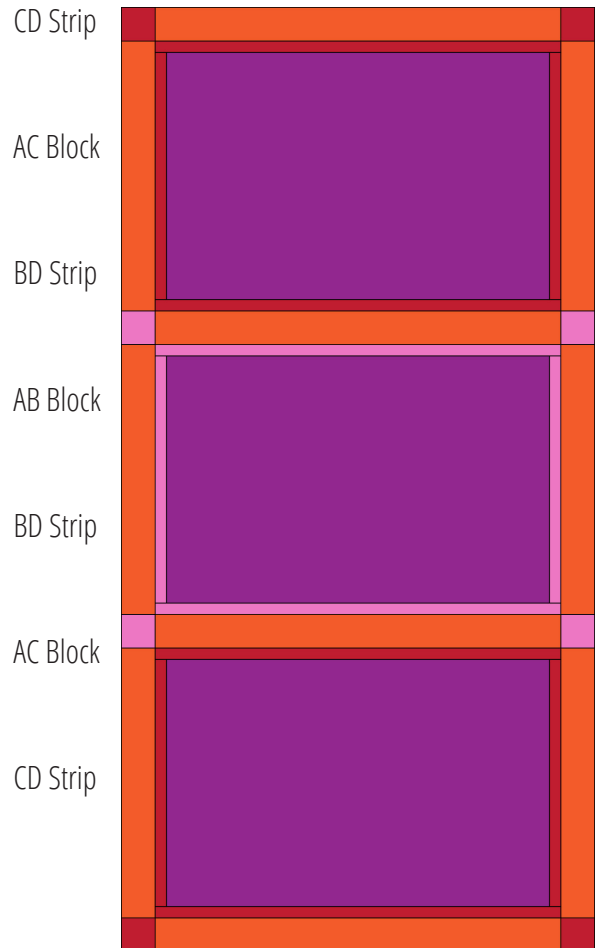


Step 5: Sew a 2" x 12½" Fabric D strip to both sides of the AC block. Press.



Repeat remaining 2" x 12½" Fabric D strips and AC panels.

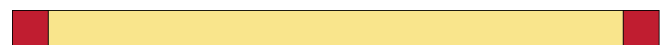
Step 6: Gather the following pieces and sew them together in the order shown. Press.



Step 7: Sew a 2" x 2" Fabric C square to both sides of a 2" x 21½" Fabric E strip. Press. Repeat to make a second CE strip.



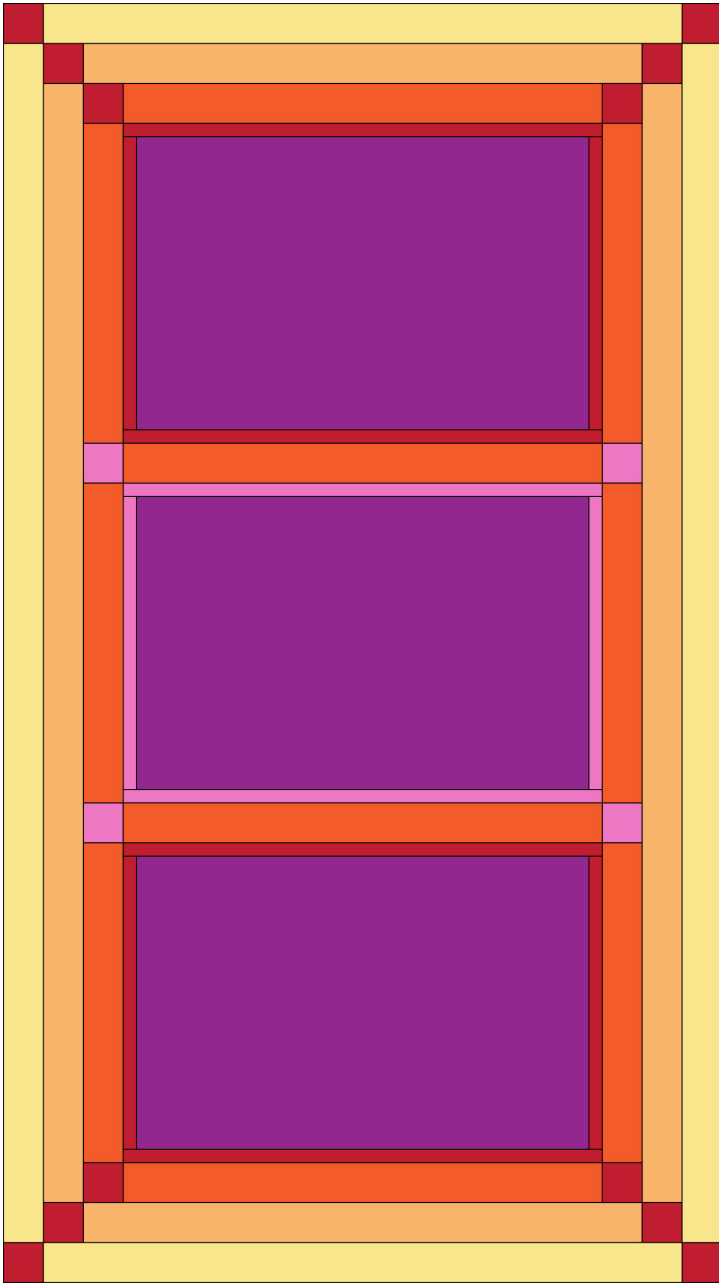
Step 8: Sew a 2" x 2" Fabric C square to both sides of a 2" x 24½" Fabric F strip. Press. Repeat to make a second CF strip.



Step 9: Sew a Fabric E 2" x 42½" strip to both sides of the wall hanging from Step 6. Press. Sew the CE strips to the top and bottom of the wall hanging. Press.

Piecing Instructions

Step 10: Sew a Fabric F 2" x 45½" strip to both sides of the wall hanging from Step 6. Press. Sew the CF strips to the top and bottom of the wall hanging. Press.



Woohoo! Your wall hanging top is finished. Now, quilt and bind using your preferred method.

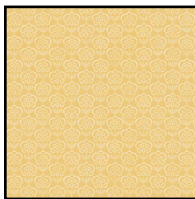
