Press seams open unless otherwise stated.

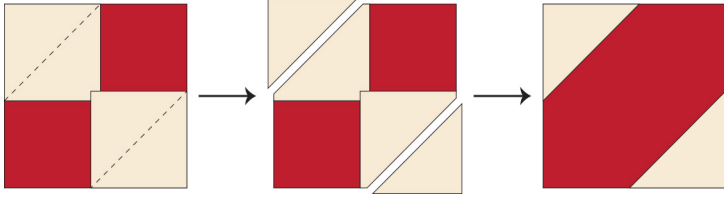
WOF = Width of Fabric (selvage to selvage)
RST = Right Sides together

Cutting Instructions

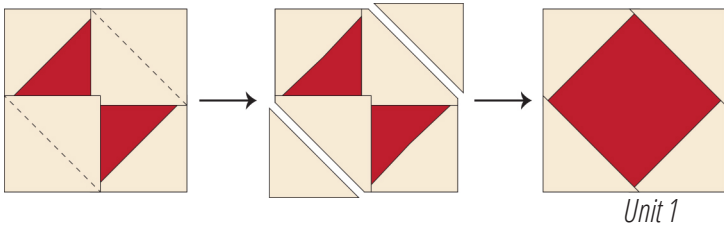
Fabric A	Fussy cut 4 placemat panels $11\frac{1}{2}" \times 17\frac{1}{2}"$
Fabric B	Cut 4 strips $1" \times \text{WOF}$ - subcut 4 strips $1" \times 11\frac{1}{2}"$ and 4 strips $1" \times 18\frac{1}{2}"$ Cut 1 strip $2" \times \text{WOF}$ - subcut 4 squares $2" \times 2"$
Fabric C	Cut 4 strips $1" \times \text{WOF}$ - subcut 4 strips $1" \times 11\frac{1}{2}"$ and 4 strips $1" \times 18\frac{1}{2}"$ Cut 1 strip $2\frac{3}{4}" \times \text{WOF}$ - subcut 8 strips $2\frac{3}{4}" \times 5"$ Cut 1 strip $4\frac{1}{4}" \times \text{WOF}$ - subcut 8 squares $4\frac{1}{4}" \times 4\frac{1}{4}"$
Fabric D	Cut 1 strip $4\frac{1}{4}" \times \text{WOF}$ - subcut 8 squares $4\frac{1}{4}" \times 4\frac{1}{4}"$ Cut 1 strip $2\frac{3}{4}" \times \text{WOF}$ - subcut 4 strips $2\frac{3}{4}" \times 5"$ and 4 squares $2\frac{3}{4}" \times 2\frac{3}{4}"$
Fabric E	Cut 1 strip $4\frac{1}{4}" \times \text{WOF}$ - subcut 8 squares $4\frac{1}{4}" \times 4\frac{1}{4}"$ Cut 1 strip $2\frac{3}{4}" \times \text{WOF}$ - subcut 8 squares $2\frac{3}{4}" \times 2\frac{3}{4}"$
Fabric F	Cut one strip $9\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{WOF}$ - subcut one $9\frac{1}{2}" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$ square trim remainder of strip down to $6\frac{1}{2}"$ wide - subcut 4 squares $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$
Fabric G	Cut 1 strip $5" \times 5"$ - subcut 8 squares $5" \times 5"$ Cut 1 strip $4\frac{1}{4}" \times \text{WOF}$ - subcut 8 squares $4\frac{1}{4}" \times 4\frac{1}{4}"$ Cut 3 strips $3\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{WOF}$ - subcut 32 squares $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$ Cut 2 strips $2\frac{3}{4}" \times \text{WOF}$ - subcut 20 squares $2\frac{3}{4}" \times 2\frac{3}{4}"$ Cut 10 strips $2" \times \text{WOF}$ • from 2 of the strips - subcut 4 strips $2" \times 18\frac{1}{2}"$ • from 3 of the strips - subcut 8 strips $2" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$ • sew the remaining strips together end to end to create one long strip - subcut 2 strips $2" \times 45\frac{1}{2}"$ and 2 strips $2" \times 48\frac{1}{2}"$
Binding	Cut 5 strips $2\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{WOF}$

Piecing Instructions

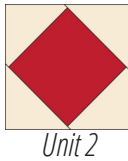
Step 1: Draw a line diagonally across the back of four 5" x 5" Fabric G squares and place 2 of them on the 9½" x 9½" Fabric F square as shown. Sew on the drawn lines and trim excess ¼" away from the sewn line. Press.



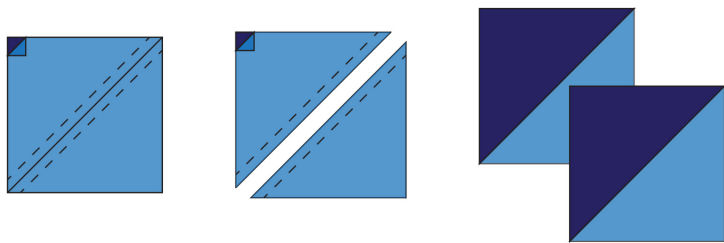
Repeat with the remaining 5" x 5" squares on the other 2 corners. Press.



Step 2: Repeat Step 1 with the four 6½" x 6½" Fabric F squares and 16 of the 3½" x 3½" Fabric G squares to make a total of four 6½" FG Square in a square blocks.



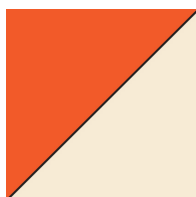
Step 3: Draw a line diagonally across the back of all 4¼" x 4¼" Fabric C squares. Place a Fabric C square on top of a Fabric D square RST and sew ¼" away from both sides of the line. Cut apart on drawn line, open and press to create 2 CD Half Square Triangles (HSTs).



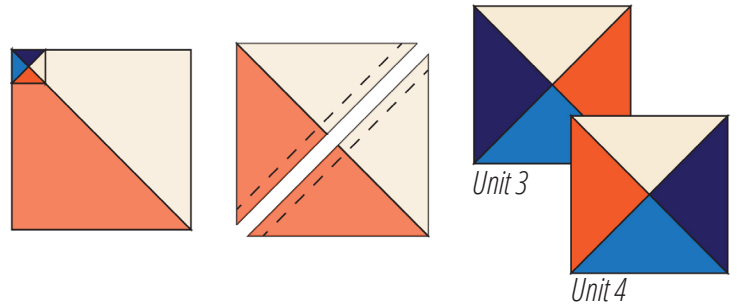
Repeat to make a total of 16 CD HSTs

Step 4: Repeat Step 3 with Fabric E and Fabric G 4¼" x 4¼" squares.

Make a total of 16 EG HSTs.

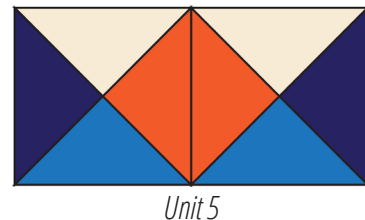


Step 5: Place a EG HST on top of a CD HST Right sides together, making sure that Fabric E is directly on top of Fabric C and Fabric G is on top of Fabric D (*see first image with pulled back corner of block below*). Draw a line across the opposite diagonal as the original sewn line and sew ¼" away from both sides of the drawn line. Cut apart on drawn line and open. Square up Quarter Square Triangles (QSTs) to 3½" x 3½".



Note that the 2 resulting QSTs are mirror images of each other. Repeat to make a total of 16 Unit 3 and 16 Unit 4.

Step 6: Gather one Unit 1 and one Unit 2 from the previous step. Sew them together as shown, noting orientation and placement of each QST. Press.

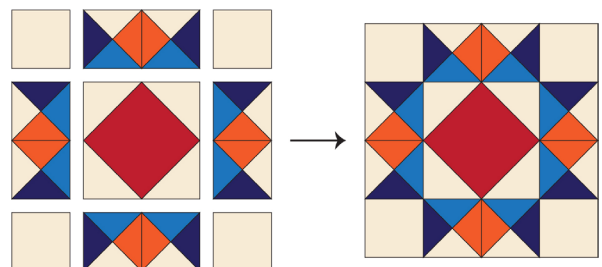


Repeat to make a total of 16 Unit 5.

Step 7: Gather the following:

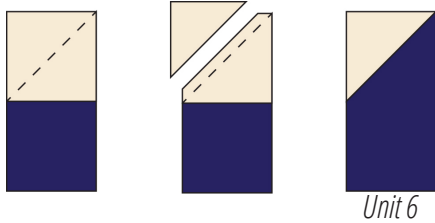
- One Unit 2
- Four 3½" x 3½" Fabric G Squares
- Four Unit 5

Lay the pieces out as shown. Sew the pieces into rows and sew the rows together. Press. Repeat to make a total of 4 Block A.



Piecing Instructions

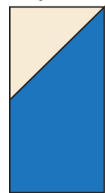
Step 8: Draw a line diagonally across the back of a $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric G square. Place it on top of a $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" Fabric D strip as shown, noting orientation of the drawn line. Sew along the drawn line and then trim excess $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn line. Press open.



Unit 6

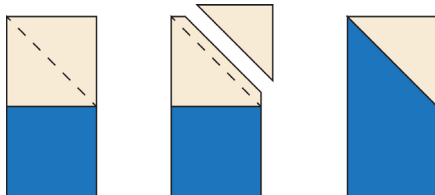
Repeat to make a total of 4 Unit 6.

Step 9: Repeat Step 8 with a $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric G square and a $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" Fabric C strip. Repeat to make a total of 4 Unit 7.



Unit 7

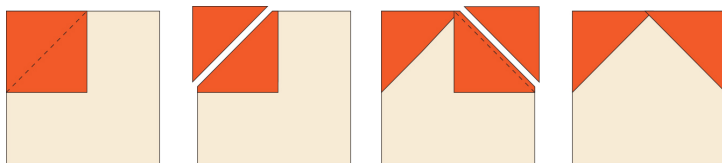
Step 10: Repeat Step 8 with a $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric G square and a $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" Fabric C strip, but this time, rotate the drawn line 90° so it is going to the opposite corner.



Unit 8

Repeat to make a total of 4 Unit 8.

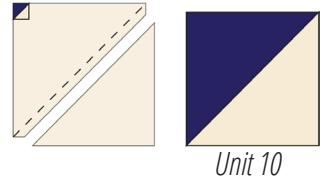
Step 11: Draw a diagonal line across the back of all $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric E Squares. Lay one RST on top of a 5" x 5" Fabric G Square as shown, noting orientation of the square. Sew on drawn line, and trim off excess $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press. Repeat for opposite corner.



Unit 9

Repeat to make a total of 4 Unit 9.

Step 12: Draw a line across the back of four $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric G Squares. Place a $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric G square on top of a $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric D square RST. Sew along drawn line and trim off excess $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Press. Repeat to make a total of 4 Unit 10.

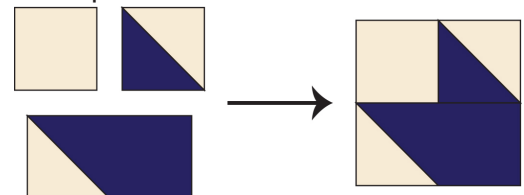


Unit 10

Step 13: Gather the following:

- One $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric G square
- One Unit 6
- One Unit 10

Lay out the pieces as shown and sew them together. Repeat to make a total of 4 Unit 11.

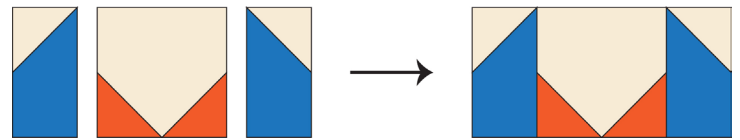


Unit 11

Step 14: Gather the following:

- One Unit 7
- One Unit 8
- One Unit 9

Lay out the pieces as shown and sew them together. Repeat to make a total of 4 Unit 12.

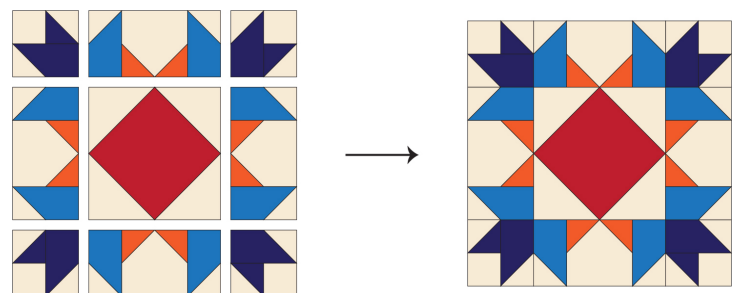


Unit 12

Step 15: To make Block B, Gather the following:

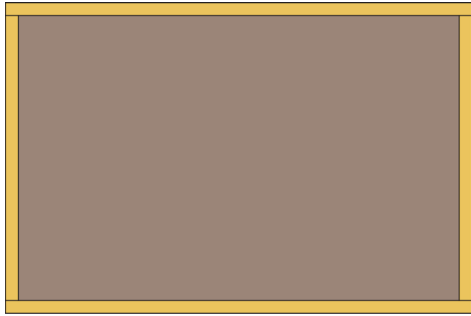
- One Unit 1
- Four Unit 11
- Four Unit 12

Lay the pieces out as shown. Sew the pieces into rows and sew the rows together. Press.



Piecing Instructions

Step 16: Sew a 1" x 11½" Fabric B strip to both sides of a Fabric A Panel. Press. Sew a 1" x 18½" Fabric B Strip to the top and bottom of the fabric A Panel. Press.



Repeat to make a total of 2 Block C.

Step 17: Sew a 1" x 11½" Fabric C strip to both sides of a Fabric A Panel. Press. Sew a 1" x 18½" Fabric C Strip to the top and bottom of the fabric A Panel. Press.

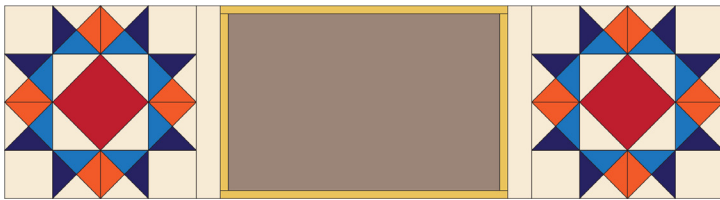


Repeat to make a total of 2 Block D.

Step 18: Gather the following:

- Two Block A
- One Block C
- Two 2" x 12½" Fabric G strips

Lay the pieces out as shown, and then sew them together. Press.

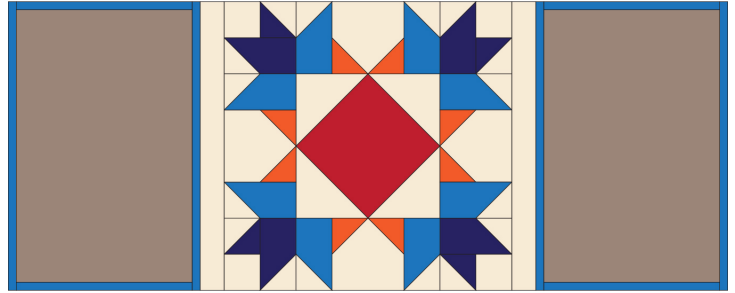


Repeat to make a second Row 1.

Step 19: Gather the following:

- Two Block D
- One Block B
- Two 2" x 18½" Fabric G strips

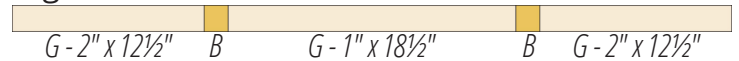
Lay the pieces out as shown, noting the orientation of the panels in the colorstory pages at the back. Sew the pieces together. Press.



Step 20: Gather the following:

- Two 2" x 12½" Fabric G strips
- One 2" x 18½" Fabric G strips
- Two 2" x 2" Fabric B squares

Lay the pieces out as shown, and then sew them together. Press.



Repeat to make a second sashing row.

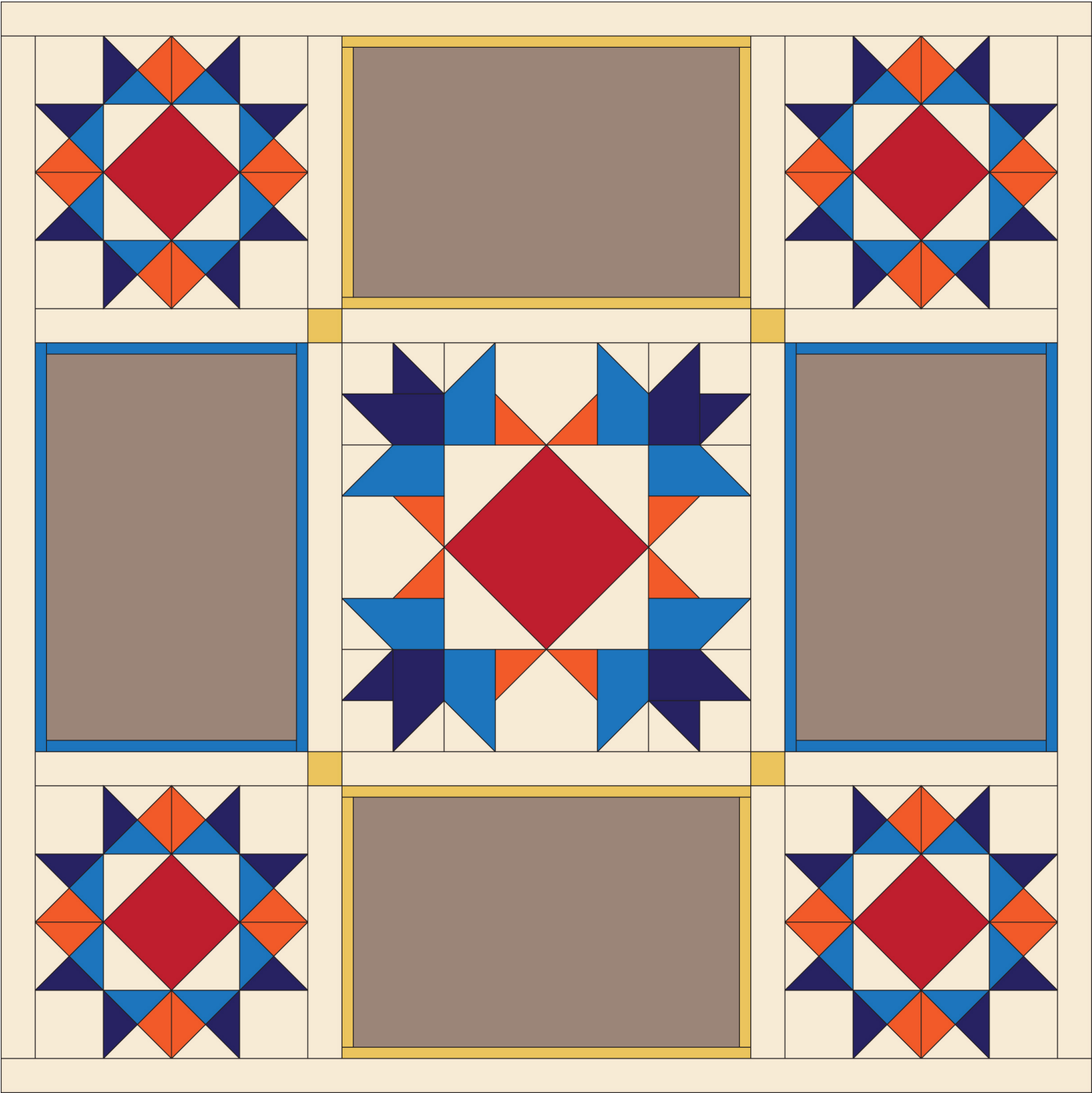
Step 20: Gather the following:

- Two Row 1
- One Row 2
- Two Sashing Rows

Lay the rows out as shown on page 5, noting the orientation of the panels in the colorstory pages at the back. Sew the rows together. Press.

Step 20: Sew the 2" x 45½" Fabric G strips to the sides of the quilt top. Press. Sew the 2" x 48½" Fabric G strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press.

Woohoo! Your quilt top is finished. Now, quilt and bind using your preferred method.



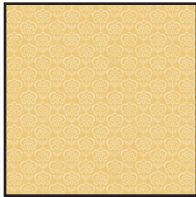
