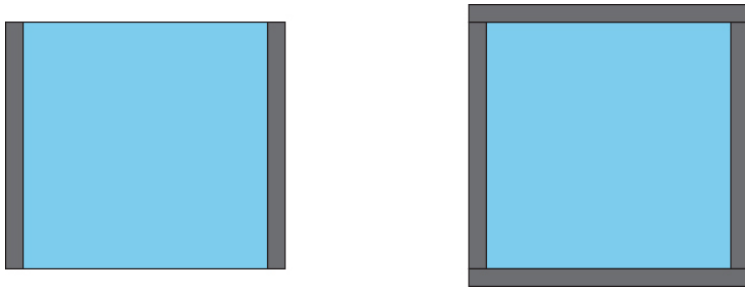
WOF = Width of Fabric (selvage to selvage)
RST = Right Sides Together
HST = Half Square Triangle

Cutting Instructions

Fabrics A-D	Cut one strip 7½" x WOF - subcut 3 squares 7½" x 7½"
Fabrics E-H	Cut 3 strips 1" x WOF - subcut 6 strips 1" x 7½" and 6 strips 1" x 8½"
Fabrics I & K	Cut 2 strips 2⅞" x 2⅞" - subcut 24 squares 2⅞" x 2⅞"
Fabrics J & L	Cut 2 strips 2⅞" x 2⅞" - subcut 24 squares 2⅞" x 2⅞" Cut 1 strip 3" x WOF - subcut 12 squares 3" x 3"
Fabric M	Cut 3 strips 5¼" x WOF - subcut 24 squares 5¼" x 5¼" Cut 2 strip 3" x WOF - subcut 24 squares 3" x 3"
Binding	Cut 5 strips 2½" x WOF

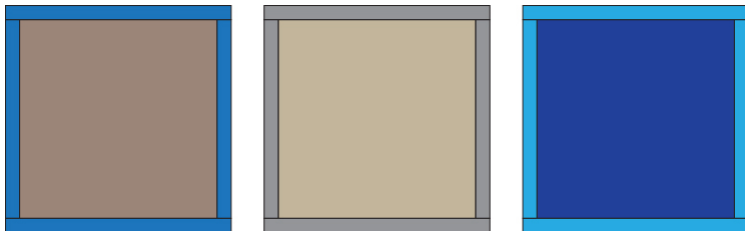
Piecing Instructions

Step 1: Sew a 1" x 7½" Fabric E strip to both sides of a 7½" x 7½" Fabric A square. Press. Sew a 1" x 8½" strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A square. Press.



Repeat for all Fabric A squares to make a total of 3 AE Blocks.

Step 2: Repeat step 1 with the following fabric combinations to make a total of 3 of each block.

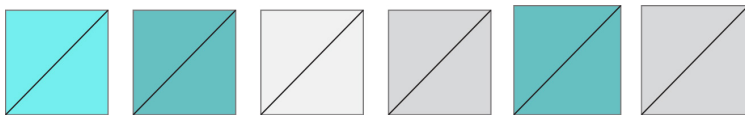


BF Block

Fabric F Strips

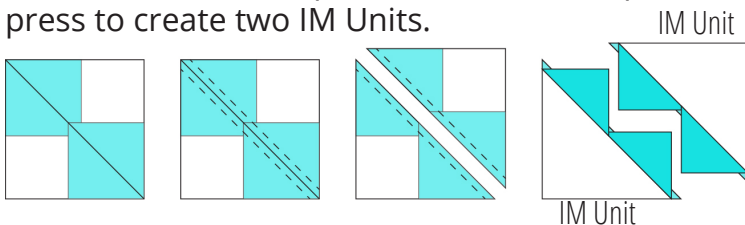
CG Block

Step 3: Draw a diagonal line across the back of all Fabrics I, J, K, and L 2⅞" x 2⅞" squares, and all Fabrics J and L 3" x 3" squares.

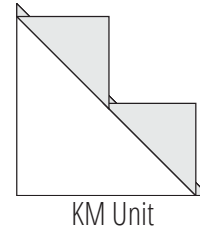


Step 4: Gather one 5¼" x 5¼" Fabric M square and two 2⅞" x 2⅞" Fabric I squares. Place the Fabric I squares on top of the Fabric M square RST as shown. Sew ¼" away from both sides of the drawn line. Cut apart on drawn line, open and press to create two IM Units.

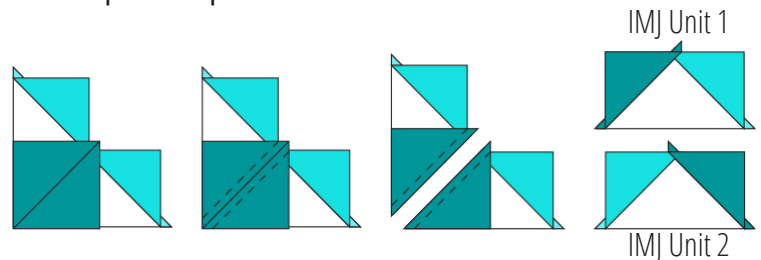


Repeat with all Fabric I 2⅞" x 2⅞" squares. to make a total of 24 IM Units.

Step 5: Repeat Step 4 with Fabric M 5¼" x 5¼" squares and Fabric K 2⅞" x 2⅞" squares to make a total of 24 KM Units.

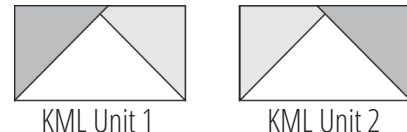


Step 6: Place a Fabric J 2⅞" x 2⅞" square on top of an IM Unit from Step 4. Sew ¼" away from both sides of the drawn line. Cut apart on drawn line, open and press to create two IMJ Units (they will be mirror images of each other). Trim dog ears and square up to 2½" x 4½" if needed.

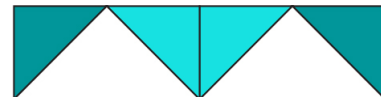


Repeat with all IM Units and Fabric J 2⅞" x 2⅞" squares to create a total of 24 IMJ Unit 1 and 24 IMJ Unit 2.

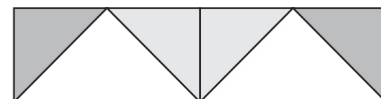
Step 7: Repeat Step 6 with the KM Units from Step 5 and the Fabric L 2⅞" x 2⅞" squares to create a total of 24 KML Unit 1 and 24 KML Unit 2.



Step 8: Sew an IMJ Unit 1 and IMJ Unit 2 together as shown. Press. Repeat for all IMJ Units to make a total of 24 IMJ Unit 3.

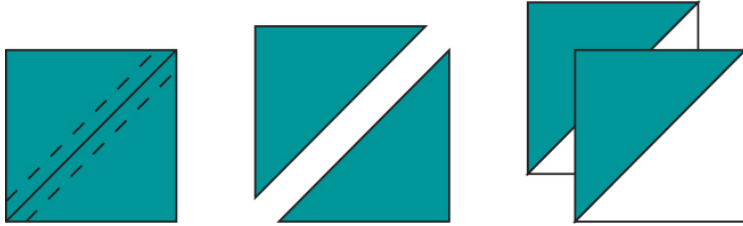


Repeat with KML Units 1 and Units 2 as shown. Make a total of 24 KML Unit 3.

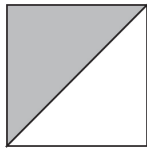


Piecing Instructions

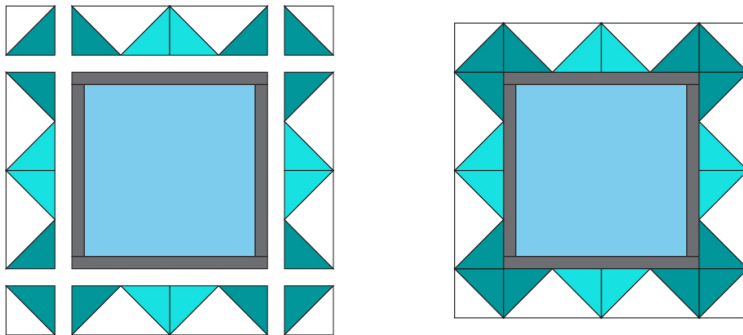
Step 9: Place a 3" x 3" Fabric J and Fabric M square RST. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of the drawn line. Cut apart on drawn line, open and press to make 2 JM HSTs. Square HSTs up to $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat to make a total of 24 JM HSTs.



Step 10: Repeat Step 8 with 3" x 3" Fabric L and Fabric M squares to make a total of 24 LM HSTs.



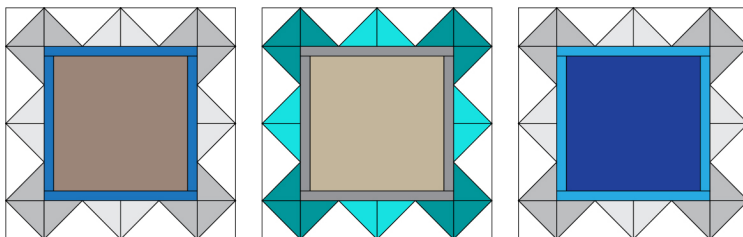
Step 11: Gather the following; 4 IMJ Unit 3, 4 JM HSTs and 1 AE Block. Lay the pieces out as shown. Sew the pieces into rows, then sew the rows together. Press. Repeat to make a total of 3 Block 1.

Step 12: Repeat Step 11 to make 3 blocks each with the following Fabrics:

- Block 2: 4 KML Unit 3, 4 LM HSTs and 1 BF Block.
- Block 3: 4 IMJ Unit 3, 4 JM HSTs and 1 CG Block.
- Block 4: 4 KML Unit 3, 4 LM HSTs and 1 DH Block.



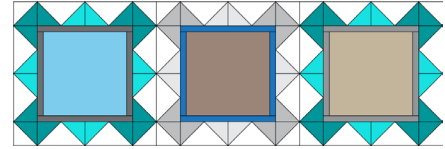

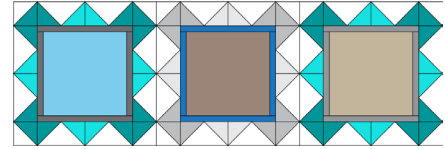

Step 13: Sew 3 blocks together into the following rows:

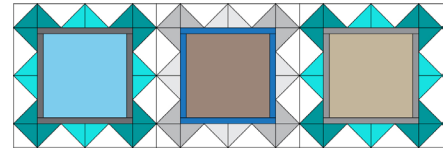
Row 1: Block 1 - Block 2 - Block 3



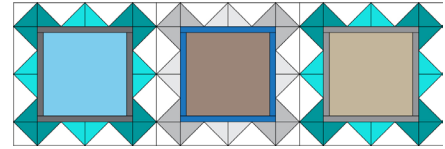
Row 2: Block 4 - Block 1 - Block 2



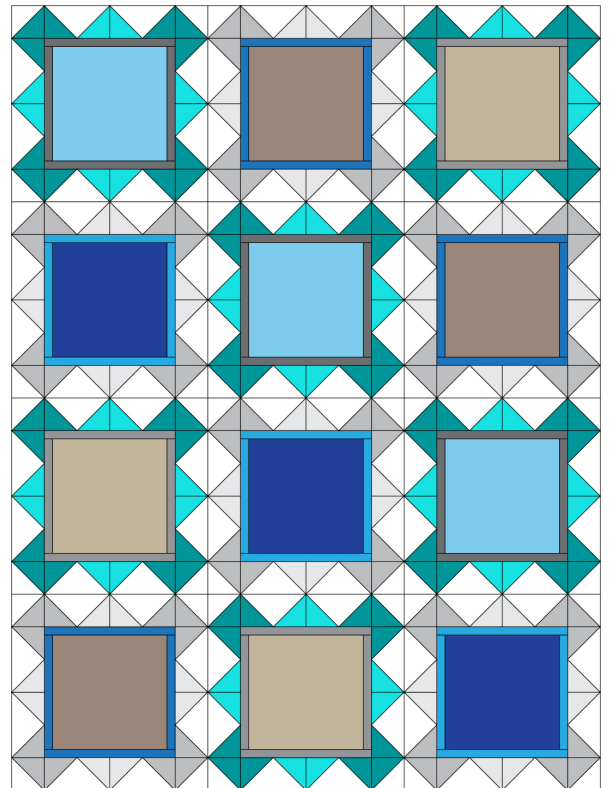
Row 3: Block 3 - Block 4 - Block 1



Row 4: Block 2 - Block 3 - Block 4



Step 14: Sew the Rows together into a finished quilt top.



Woohoo! Your quilt top is finished. Now, quilt and bind using your preferred method.
