

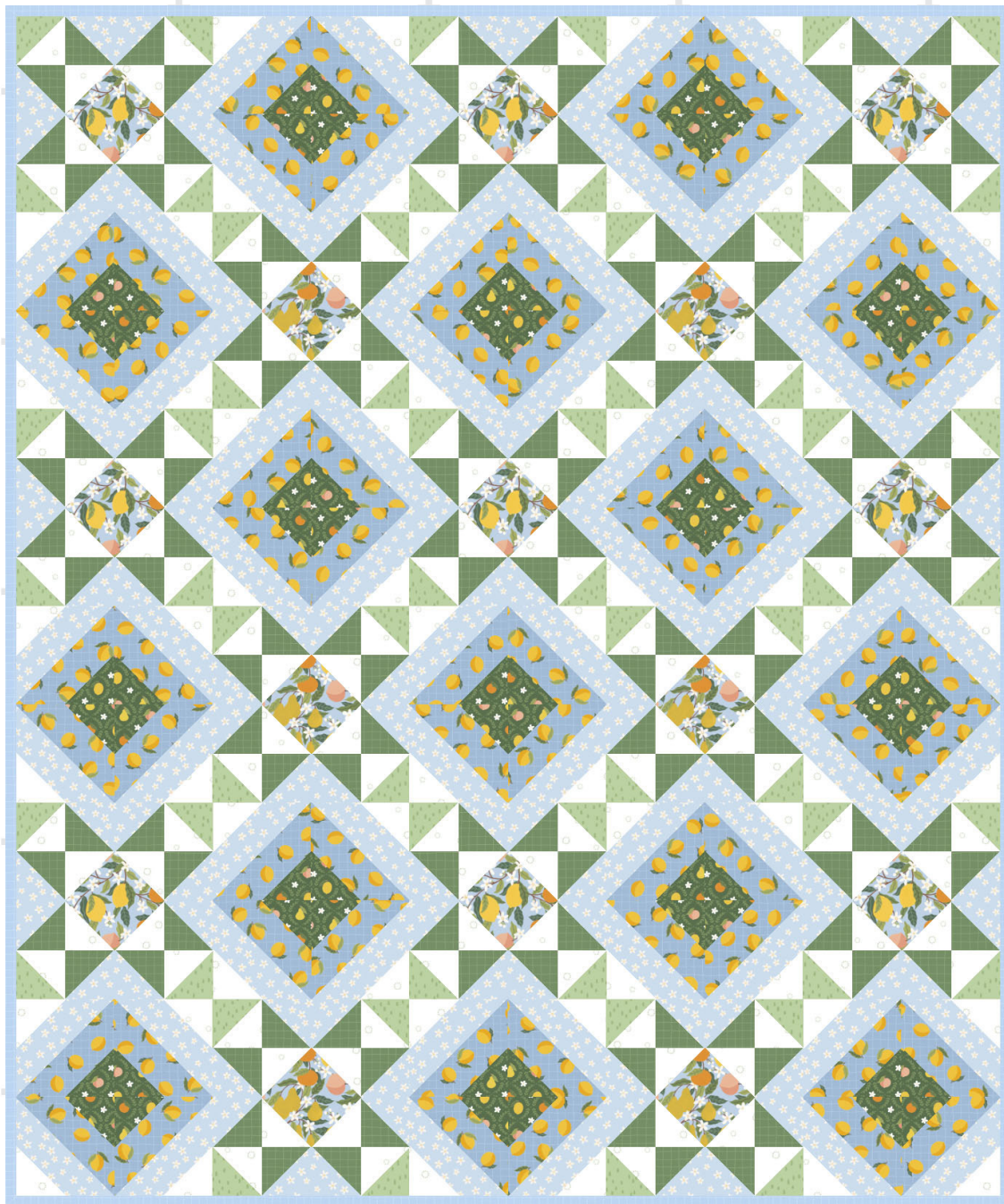

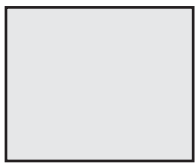

All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " unless otherwise stated.
Press seams open unless otherwise stated.

WOF = Width of Fabric (selvage to selvage)
LOF = Width of Fabric (selvage to selvage)
RST = Right Sides Together

Cutting Instructions

A	3 - $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF cut into 30 - $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares
B	8 - $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF cut into 120 - $2\frac{3}{4}$ " squares
C	4 - $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF cut into 60 - $2\frac{3}{4}$ " squares
D	8 - $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF strips cut into 60 - $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" strips 5 - $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF cut into 30 - $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
E	5 - $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF cut into 30 - $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
F	2 - 5" x WOF cut into 15 - 5" squares
G	8 - $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF cut into 120 - $2\frac{3}{4}$ " squares 3 - $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF cut into 30 - $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares
Binding	5 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips

Piecing Instructions

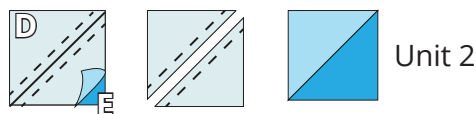
Step 1: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all of the $2\frac{3}{4}$ " B, C, and G squares, the $3\frac{1}{4}$ " G squares and the $5\frac{1}{2}$ " D squares.



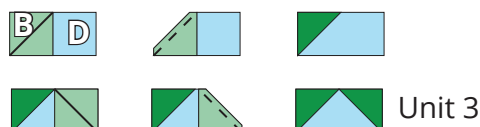
Step 2: Arrange a marked $3\frac{1}{4}$ " G square with a $3\frac{1}{4}$ " A square RST. Sew on each side of the diagonal line, $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the diagonal line as shown. Cut on the center line. Press both. Trim each to a $2\frac{3}{4}$ " square, making sure to center the seam. Make sixty Units 1.



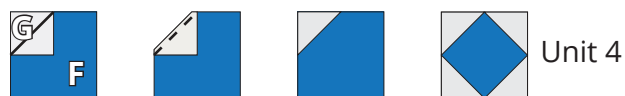
Repeat with a marked $5\frac{1}{2}$ " D square and a $5\frac{1}{2}$ " E square. Trim each to a 5" square, making sure to center the seam. Make sixty Units 2.



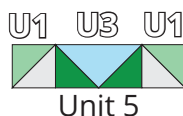
Step 3: Arrange a marked $2\frac{3}{4}$ " B square on the left side of a $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" D rectangle as shown, RST. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press. Repeat on the right side. Make sixty Units 3.



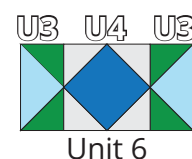
Step 4: Arrange a marked $2\frac{3}{4}$ " G square on a corner of a 5" F square as shown, RST. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press. Repeat for all four corners. Make fifteen Units 4.



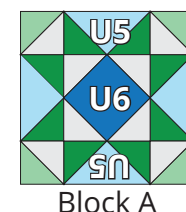
Step 5: Arrange two Units 1 with one Unit 3 in a row as shown. Sew together. Press. Make thirty Units 5.



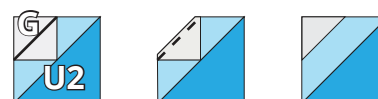
Step 6: Arrange two Units 3 with one Unit 4 in a row as shown. Sew together. Press. Make fifteen Units 6.



Step 7: Arrange a Unit 5 on the top and bottom of a Unit 6 as shown. Sew together. Make fifteen Blocks A.



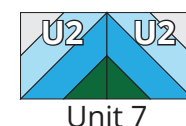
Step 8: Arrange a marked $2\frac{3}{4}$ " G square on the D triangle corner of a Unit 2 as shown, RST. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press. Repeat for all sixty Units 2.



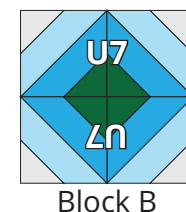
Step 9: Arrange a marked $2\frac{3}{4}$ " C square on the E triangle corner of a Unit 2 as shown, RST. Sew along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press. Repeat for all sixty Units 2.



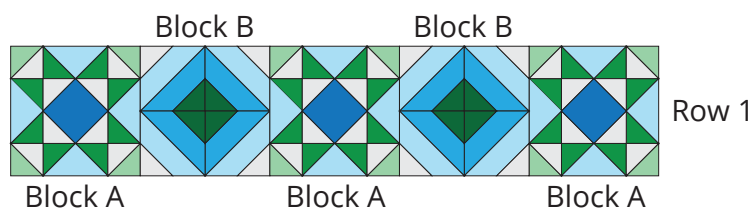
Step 10: Arrange two Units 2 together with the C triangles touching as shown. Sew together. Press. Make thirty Units 7.



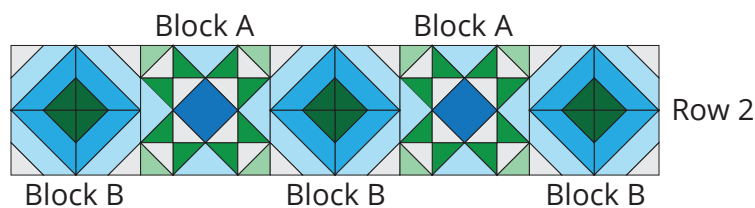
Step 11: Arrange two Units 7 together with the C triangles touching as shown. Sew together. Press. Make fifteen Blocks B.



Step 12: Arrange three Blocks A with two Blocks B, alternating the blocks as shown. Sew the row together. Press as you sew. Make three Rows 1.

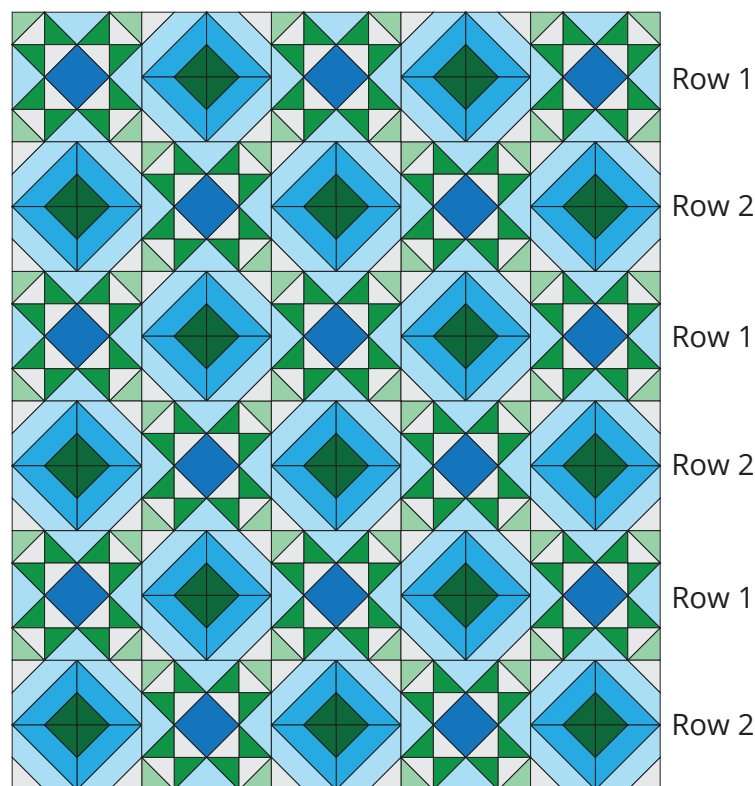


Step 13: Arrange three Blocks B with two Blocks A, alternating the blocks as shown. Sew the row together. Press as you sew. Make three Rows 2.



Step 14: Starting with a Row 1 and alternating rows, sew the rows together to make the quilt top. Press as you sew.

Step 15: *Woohoo!* Your quilt top is finished. Now, quilt and bind using your preferred method.



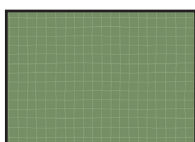

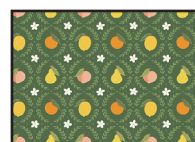
